A SYNOPSIS OF THE POLECIES TO SOVERE EXAMINATION OF SPRCIMENS
BY THE WASSIRMANN LABORATORY.

It is the policy of the Laboratory to make assermann examinations of blood or spinal fluid, without charge, for State, county and city institutions and hospitals, private hospitals and institutions, local beards of health and private physicians, which conferm to the rules of the unberstory.

1-INSTITUTIONS. Arrangements for service for institutions should be made directly with the Laboratory, where the proper information as to the manner of submitting specimens can be given to those in charge of any of those institutions. This is partially covered by the circular letter attached. In the case of private hospitals and private institutions, the Wassermann service is to be granted only under the condition that the hospital or institution make no charge to the patient for such examinations.

2-PRIVATE PHYSICIAES. Private physicians may obtain the service of the Laberatory through (1) local boards of health (2) State district health officore or (3) by sending the potient to the Laboratory on Puckage and Thursdays between three and five P.M.

3-LOCAL BOARD OF HEALTH. In the case of local boards of health it is neccessary that the authorized agent of such a board communicate with the Birector of Communicable Discusses or the State district health officer, who will announce the policy governing submitting of specimens by local boards. The local board of health must assume the responsibility for the proper use of the Laboratory facilities. This applies particularly to a definite understanding that no physician shall make a charge for any Massermann test done by the State Laboratory, and that only registered physicians be given the privileges of the Laboratory.

of each outlit dispensed, with the same of the physician who obtained it, the name of initials of the patient upon whom the test is to be made, and the date the outlit was obtained. Blank forms for this purpose are furnished by the Laboratory. This amplicate must be returned to the Laboratory on the first of each month. The agent of the local board of health must sign "was sermann Form 4" when dispensing a massermann patrict to a private physician.

with the Jassermann Laboratory, writes directly to the Laboratory for outfits, a letter will be sent to the agent or such a board of health montioning the fact that he must consult directly with the district health officer
who will give the information above stated with regard to the submitting of
specimens. At the same time this letter goes forth, a letter will be
written to the state district health officer concerned, savising that he get
in touch with the agent of the local board of health who has applied for
Jassermann service.

4-TAIN DESTRICT HEALTH DEFICIANT. Then private physicians submit specimens by direction of State district health officers, the State district health officer should also keep similar records as to the name of the physician and initials of the patient, etc., as kept by any local board of health. Further, they should always sign the clip identifying the specimen. "Vaccement Form 4", in order that the Laboratory may know by whose direction the specimen is to be submitted.

b-DIRECTIONS FOR SUBSTITING STROTTERS BY LOCAL BOARDS OF HEALTH AND DISTRICT
HEALTH OFFICERS. Owing to the fact that a large number of specimens submitted by direction of local boards of health and district health officers
reach the Laboratory in a hemolyzed condition and are therefore unsuitable
for testing we recommend very strongly that the local boards of health sequaint
themselves with the method of withdrawing serums from the clots. The method

7-AMPORTS TO LOCAL BOARDS OF REALTH AND STATE DISTRICT HEALTH OFFICERS. In the case of specimens submitted by direction of a local board of health or a state district health officer a duplicate of the report sent to the private physiciam will be mailed to the district health officer, or the the duly qualified officer of the local board of health, unless the "Massermann Form 4" accompanying the specimen directs to the contrary. In no event, however, is it the policy of the haboratory to give reports to non-medical persons connected with public or private institutions, or to deal directly with petients in the matter of advice as to treatment or significance of the Wassermann tests, atc. On the other hand, the haboratory wishes to cooperate with physicians and fastitutions by giving advise as to disposition of patients, the interpretation of tests, otc.
