

MEETINGS

ARTICLE 5.

- SEC. 1. The annual meeting of the League shall be held in the town hall of Shelburne, Vt., on the last Tuesday in October.
- SEC. 2. The League shall hold at least one meeting each month and at such other time as may be ordered by the League, or called by the Executive Committee.
- SEC. 3. Ten members present at any meeting of the League shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.

COMMITTEES.

ARTICLE 6.

- SEC. 1. The following committees shall be appointed by the League at the first annual meeting of each year, consisting of not less than three members each, viz: 1st, An auditing committee which shall audit the accounts of the treasurer and render a report in writing at the annual meeting.

AMENDMENTS.

ARTICLE 7.

- SEC. 1. This constitution may be amended at any regular meeting by two-thirds vote of the members present, such amendment having been presented in writing at a previous meeting

CONSTITUTION AND BY-LAWS OF THE SHELBURNE, VERMONT IMPROVEMENT LEAGUE

NAME.

ARTICLE 1.

- SEC. 1. The name of the Association shall be the Shelburne Improvement League.

OBJECT.

ARTICLE 2.

- SEC. 1. The object of this League shall be the improvement and beautifying of the town of Shelburne.

MEMBERS.

ARTICLE 3.

- SEC. 1. Any adult person may become a member of this League by signing the constitution and paying to the treasurer, 25c. annually.
- SEC. 2. Any child under the age of 15 years may become an associate member of this League by paying to the treasurer, 10c. annually.

SEC. 3. All members agree to do what they can to promote the objects of the League, First, by informing their neighbors of the purpose of the League, and by soliciting them to become members of the same; Second, and especially in the care and cleanliness and improvement of their own grounds walks, and alleys adjacent.

SEC. 4. Annual dues shall be payable on November 1, of each year. Neglect to pay the same by January 1, shall forfeit membership in the League.

OFFICERS.

ARTICLE 4.

SEC. 1. The officers shall be president, 1st vice-president, 2nd vice-president, secretary and treasurer, who shall perform the duties common to these officers in other organizations.

SEC. 2. These officers together with six members to be elected as provided by Article 4, Section 4, shall constitute an Executive Committee which shall transact the general business of the League subject to its approval, and shall make a full report at the annual meeting. Any one or all of these offices may be held by a woman.

SEC. 3. Five members of the Executive Committee shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business, meetings of the committee shall be held at the call of the president.

SEC. 4. Said officers and members of the Executive Committee shall be elected by ballot at the first regular meeting of each year, and shall hold their office until their successor is elected.

SEC. 5. The treasurer shall make a written report at the end of the year of all receipts and disbursements, and at such other time as may be ordered by the League.

SEC. 6. The treasurer shall pay out money only on the order of the League or Executive Committee.

SEC. 7. The Executive Committee shall employ all laborers, make all contracts, expend all moneys, direct and superintend all improvements of the League at its discretion.

SEC. 8. At the meeting of the Executive Committee next preceding the annual meeting of the League, a committee to be known as the "nominating committee," shall be appointed to report at the annual meeting, a list of the officers and Executive Committee proposed for the coming year.

SEC. 9. The Executive Committee shall have power to appoint any sub-committee it may deem advisable.

SEC. 10. No bills for labor or material shall be paid by the treasurer unless approved in writing by three (3) members of the Executive Committee and no bill shall be so approved which is for a sum greater than the appropriation for the special purpose covered by such bill.
