George O'Brien house Dorset St. & Barstow Rd.

April 2, 1794 Charles Hamilton to Roswell Miner (or Minor) the portion of Lot #117 lying in Shelburne for 90 pounds.

Roswell Miner had a child born in Shelburne in 1795, so must have had some sort of a dwelling. He died in 1809 at 56 yrs.

Samuel Miner purchased all the other heirs' shares of his father's estate from 1812-1827.

June 6, 1838 Samuel Miner to Martin L. Miner 169 acres w/dwelling house and other buildings. Samuel Miner died in 1854 at 71 yrs. Aug. 20, 1882 Will of Martin L. Miner (will was written in 1874) leaves property including dwelling house to son Charles E. Miner. Martin died July 11, 1882 at 68 yrs.

This property stayed in the Miner family until Charles sold to William J. Parker on 2/11/1908.

It would seem as though this house must have been built prior to 1838.
