Now, let us look at a brief summary of the descendants of Phineas
and Daniel. Phineas Lake was Dorsey and Clara's great, great, grandfather.
Phineas' son, Curtis, was Dorsey's great grandfather; Curtis' daughter
Willie, who married Ira Andrews, was Dorsey's grandmother, and Ora Lake's
son, Gilson, was Dorsey's father. Phineas' son, Hazelton, was Clara's great,
grandfather, and Daniel's son, Hazelton, who married Deborah Miller, was
Clara's grandfather and Hazelton's son, Edgar, was Clara's father.

Curtis, the first child of Phineas and Elizabeth, married Mary
Huston and settled in Canaan, N.Y. where he lived until he came to
Stratford in 1801. Here he settled in the north part of Charlottes,
near the Shelburne Line, just east of Log Corners and near his father,
Phineas. Again he moved to a small house on the south side of
