3.1 Correspondence from Jane Blinn to Mrs. Tracy, 16 Sept 1966. Thirteen pages. Photocopy of typewritten correspondence. Contents "Vermont Blinns", "Bela's records is as follows before coming to Shelburne", "From Town hall records and Shelburne library", "Vermont History on the Blinns from Montpelier Records" (vital records), "Shelburne Deaths" (and other vital records), "Shelburne the town clerk records" (deeds), "Chart on Blin from Shelburne" (typewritten vs. actual chart, narrative of Blinn family in Shelburne.

3.2 Photocopy of research notes, BLIN-N Pages 201 and 202. "Here's what James W. Hill (See Series 4.1- adopted son of Willin T. Hill has to say of the Blin-n families as he has found them."

3.3 Photocopy of two typewritten pages with small attached note signed by Jane Blin. It speaks to how Jane Blin conducted her research and includes information about potential sources of information at the New England Genealogical Society (Boston, MA)

3.4 Photocopy of research notes about "Enos Blin(n) son of Samuel born 1796", with information regarding Burlington, Vermont. Author and date unknown, two pages.

3.5 Photocopy of research notes, Author and date unknown. Five pages. Includes service information with source information, 1800 census record notes, ‘problems’.

3.6 Photocopy of a typewritten note to Mr. Buchanan, October 25, 1933 from Shelburne, Vermont, author unknown, but in the letter reads “We have in our Town Library a Blin Genealogy.....” so can assume from the Pierson Library, Shelburne, Vermont.
