1992 Lakeland, Fla. — Lilie Hardy, 93, died on Friday, April 3. She was a former resident of Lincolnville, where she lived until her retirement to Florida.

She was born in Walkerville, Ohio, on March 28, 1899, the daughter of William F. and Gertrude Wampler Packard. A 1919 graduate of Camden High School, she taught school at Wiley Corner, Searsmont and Lincolnville.
