

*[Letter from W.H. Edwards to Arno Knight; Edwards did business with Arno when he lived out in Colarado]*

Maysville April 18 1882

Friend Knight I Recd your letter I was glad to hear from you  
Drinkwater is working in Billings Tunnel he is well & was down Monday went right  
back There is some Boys from your place living in your cabin Coperning [?] Editor  
of Democrat was elected Mayor, Frank Osborn run against him Ayers Clerk  
Charley Lee the Barber run against him indipendent he wasn't thought of at the  
Convention

Walick is marshall again The Town is on the gain that is in my business & the Hotel  
Business Smith & Gray has comensed work Billin is in 1000 feet he took a surveyor  
up with him the other day. It is reported he has at that time struck a 4 or 3 feet & I  
don't remember which of solid Galena they had an Assay from some Rock from  
Shavano that run \$600 to the ton to Big that is to believe Haynes has been  
Appointed Post Master

Pap Painter is under Sheriff at Buena Vista feels as big as a Country Stud Horse  
Cree has Kind of Turned over to the Democrats & is intending to run for Legislator  
next Fall thinks he will get both Parties to vote for him well Cary says Tell Knight to  
come Back & that his little pack is fat as a Hog
