Waldo September the 9th 1829

Dear Friend

I take this opportunity to inform you that I am well and I hope that these few lines will find you enjoying the same blessing I don't expect to see you short of two or three weeks and if you wish to have some money of me you must come and get it I expect to have some in about a week and you must not think have [because] I did not get it before I have lived with H Edgecomb half a month and I shall come home as soon as I am done and if you choose you may wait until [??] me home you must give my respects to all the folks my pen is poor my ink is thin and you must read it as well as you can
