

Thursday, January 1 Clear & cold. 14 below, early. Arne had hard work to start car. Went to Trap after Geo. Bullock & brought him home to dinner then about 4 o'clock took him to Camden as he was going back to Boston. Flossie called to get saw left for fileing.

Friday, January 2 4 below in morning and looked stormy in P.M. I washed white clothes. Myra came in, in the afternoon. Jessie Pendleton came while she was here to pay phone. Arne bought box of Larkin toilet soap of her.

Saturday, January 3 12 above in morning. Snowed all day and turned to rain in evening. Only a few inches of snow fell and not much rain. Arne's birthday. He went to the Ctr. in P.M. after oranges etc. Reita & Marion came in.

Sunday, January 4 Warm & springlike. 22 above in morning. Took Arno for a ride in his carriage. Chas. Grey called to get apples. We also had as callers – Allen Miller, Horace & 2 girls, Papa, John Wiley, Freddy, Parker, Myra & Marion.

Monday, January 5 Warm & Springlike. Arno cut first tooth. Arne packed apples. Mr. & Mrs. M.F. Dickey made door-yard call. Cop made Collier Hills put his car in, in Camden as he was driving with 1924 plates. Virgil took Arne's truck & towed him out of village so he could get home.

Tuesday, January 6 20 above zero. Cloudy. Leslie Grey had Arne's truck to go to Belfast as he hadn't got his licence. Uncle Avans came over a while in the A.M. Stanley, Freddy, Myra, Parker & Marion came in. Heard radio play given by W.G.Y. players.

Wednesday, January 7 2 above zero. Looked stormy. Arne packed apples. Joe Mullin came on telephone business and stayed to dinner. Marion came in after school. Myra was at F.B. meeting. Freddy & Parker came in & listened to radio after supper.

Thursday, January 8 32 above zero. Fair. Stormed a very little in the night. Parker & Freddy went with 2 loads of apples for Arne. Papa went first trip. I made citron preserves. Also washed a little. Marion came a few min. after school.

Friday, January 9 20 above zero. Fair. Arne went up to R. Libbys & changed his phone. I washed. Marion came in early while I was dressing Arno and bought 2 eggs. Arne sold eggs to Miller for 56¢ Mr. Wiley was paying 58¢

Saturday, January 10 8 above zero. Fair. Arno cut his second tooth. Arne packed apples. I ironed, cooked etc. Took Arno out in his carriage after dinner. Norma & Marion came in a while in the evening.

Sunday, January 11 18 above zero. Had a little snow squall in the morning. Fair the rest of the day. Marion was here to dinner. Felt glum with a cold & had a nap in the afternoon. Herbert McCobb called a while in the P.M. In the evening Parker came in & sang old songs for Arne's father.

Monday, January 12 6 below zero. Partly cloudy. Parker went with a load of apples for Arne. Arne rolled more from the cellar into the kitchen. I did a little of this & a little of that and not much of anything. Didn't feel very good.

Tuesday, January 13 Snowed in the night and turned to rain about 8 o'clock and cleared around noontime. Everett came up with his collection report. Arne did telephone writing most all day. I washed some in the P.M.

but didn't get them out.

Wednesday, January 14 Fair. Arno 9 months old today. Arne took us in the sedan over to Myra's to get him weighed. He weighed just 22 lbs. Myra came in a little while before dinner. Baby has cold in his nose. I hung out clothes got them dry & washed more.

Thursday, January 15 16 below zero. Fair. Arne finished packing a load of apples & Parker took them to the boat. Gladys came up for a while after Fred got home from Belfast with the mail.

Friday, January 16 4 below zero. Started to snow in the forenoon & snowed the rest of the day. I sewed a little and churned. Put 1 layer in jar. Arne sawed wood in P.M. Arno seems about over his cold.

Saturday, January 17 14 above zero. Mostly fair. Arne packed apples. Baby was fussy so I didn't get much done. Washed bibs & nighties beside the regular jobs. Everett had the bay horse to go Wiley's Corner way hunting line trouble.

Sunday, January 18 Fair. Arne packed apples. Baby was kind of fussy. I made strawberry ice cream. Did cross word puzzle in Camden Herald. Myra, Marion, Norma & Parker came in. Freddy & Irving helped Arne roll apples up out of the cellar.

Monday, January 19 20 below zero. Mostly fair. Arne sent Parker with 16 bbls of apples. I helped Arne stencil them & mended. Parker brought up grain & 100 lbs of rolled oats for us & a number of bags of flour for John Collamer.

Tuesday, January 20 2 below zero. Started to snow before noon & snowed fine the rest of the day. I washed a little, made pumpkin pies & sewed some. Arne packed apples, chopped up slabs etc.

Wednesday, January 21 Zero. Fair. Arne packed apples, then he & Parker went with 6 bbls. on the truck. It was hard going & they had to shovel some. Brought back 800 of grain. I stenciled barrels, sewed, shoveled a path back of the house etc.

Thursday, January 22 24 above zero. Hazy & raw. Arne packed apples, sawed wood and hunted trouble on line 24. I stenciled barrels & did this & that as usual. Freddy took 12 bbls. of apples for Arne with Parker's team.

Myra & Marion came in.

Friday, January 23 14 below zero. Very windy & cold all day. Fred Dickey started for Belfast and came back as it was drifted. I mended stockings, etc. Freddy came over & got some cross word puzzles.

Saturday, January 24 12 above zero. Fair in A.M. Snow flurries in P.M. Saw the total (most here) eclipse of sun in the forenoon. All covered but a little of the top. Sent back radio we had been trying. I washed white clothes. Myra came in about noon & read to Mr. Knight. Arne & Everett took the team & went to Hope Corner to splice a wire & came back & looked for trouble on 24.

Sunday, January 25 14 above zero. Partly cloudy. Got up late, only had 2 meals. Joe & Horace were here all the P.M. doing telephone business. Allie Crooker also came. I lugged Arno & went over to Myra's. Parker lugged him back for me as it was hard walking for me in the snow. Marion was in.

Monday, January 26 22 above zero. Partly fair. Snow flurries in P.M. Arne went out on line 24 & found trouble at Helen Martin's. I ironed etc. Marion came in after school & we worked on cross word puzzle. Earl was here in A.M. Myra came in & read a while to Mr. Knight.

Tuesday, January 27 8 above zero. Snowed fine all day. Arne sawed wood. I looked over some old clothes, churned etc. Mont brought up a radio in snowmobile. Don Heald here taking Farm census. Marion & Freddy came in the evening.

Wednesday, January 28 14 below zero. Fair. Arne did telephone writing and went to phone meeting in P.M. I cooked, washed etc. Myra & Parker came in late to listen to radio but it wasn't good. I had gone to bed.

Thursday, January 29 18 below zero. Snow some during day. Hung out clothes washed the day before. Papa came up & had Arne file, set, joint etc. a saw. Packed apples in P.M. Everett had a gray horse to go to F. Kimball's. Myra, Parker, Marion & Freddy came in the evening.

Friday, January 30 Stopt snowing about the middle of forenoon. Cold & blustery. The last day of school. It was such a bad day the Belfast mail didn't

Sunday, February 1 34 above zero. Partly cloudy. Arne looked at radio books that Parker brought in. Packed apples in P.M. Myra came in & read to Mr. Knight & wrote to Flora for him. Freddy came in. We listened to radio in evening.

Monday, February 2 4 above zero. Started to snow about 9 o'clock & snowed hard all day. Freddy went with 15 bbl. of apples for Arne. Arne packed apples killed 3 roosters etc. I fixed me a skirt, washed, dressed roosters, etc. Marion & Parker was in. Got good radio programs from WBZ & WGX. Everett had gray horse to go down on turnpike.

Tuesday, February 3 2 above zero. Fair. Arne packed apples. Didn't write Tues. and couldn't remember what took place.

Wednesday, February 4 10 above zero. Snowed a while in the forenoon. Arne changed antenna, packed apples etc. I washed some. Myra came in after milk.

Thursday, February 5 4 above zero. Spit snow in morning but cleared and was lovely rest of day. Arne headed apples and Freddy went with 10 bbls. Hard traveling was 3 ¾ hrs going down. Brought up a 100 lbs. sugar from

Mr. Wileys. Heard Old Time program from WBZ.

Friday, February 6 22 above zero. Fair & Warm. Arne shifted vinegar into different bbls. as some were partly used out. Got apples from cellar to kitchen etc. I washed, swept up stairs, shoveled path back of house etc. Howland Lassell came to get Arne to fix his flashlight. Marion and Freddy came in.

Saturday, February 7 Fair & warm. Arne packed apples. I washed, ironed and churned. Didn't feel well so left the dishes and went to bed early. Took the baby out a little while after dinner. Everett had gray horse to go on line 6.

Sunday, February 8 Fair & warm. Arne packed apples, cleaned out henhouse, sawed wood etc. Norma & Marion came in. Myra had gray horse & sleigh to carry Norma back to Camden. I made ice cream. Parker & Freddy came in.

Monday, February 9 Fair & warm. Arne sent Freddy with 12 bbls. of apples. Arno & I went over to Myra's a little while in P.M. Mattie, Kenneth & Gladys came up in the evening to listen to radio. It didn't come in good. Marion was in.

Tuesday, February 10 34 above zero. Showery. Arne went up & got the horses shod. Took the sedan battery, that we had been using with radio, down to have Virgil recharge. Myra came in & read to Mr. Knight. Clum Shepherd shot and killed himself. Parker & Marion came in.

Wednesday, February 11 Warm. Partly fair with showers in late afternoon and during night. Thunder and lightning first of evening. Arne packed apples, helped Parker with his antenna, etc. Got Lincoln's birthday program from WBZ given by The Sons of Vet. & Sons of Vet. Aux.

Thursday, February 12 Foggy & stormy. Everett had gray horse to go to Hope. Arne packed, headed & stenciled apples. Freddy cut his thumb and Arne went over & did it up. Marion was here to dinner. Arno gets hold of the side of his box & pulls himself onto his feet. Parker & Freddy came in.

Friday, February 13 Fair & warm. I washed. Arne got up apples from the cellar into the kitchen. Freddy, Myra, Parker, Marion came in.

Saturday, February 14 22 above zero. Fair. Arne went to Center and worked some in central office, then went up to Mr. Flagg's to fix phone & put

in batteries at Allen Millers. Arno was 10 months old and I took him into Myra's to get him weighed. He weighed 23 ½ lbs. Myra & Marion came in.

Sunday, February 15 Cloudy & stormy looking. Started to rain at 4 P.M. Arne packed apples. Went down to Virgil's in truck. Freddy came in and had Arne dress his hand.

Monday, February 16 Warm & mostly fair. Arne went with 2 loads of apples 15 bbls. each. Called at Gladys with oranges for Aunt Em. Took some apples up to Aunt Nell. Myra & Marion came in.

Tuesday, February 17 Cloudy & showers in P.M. Arne & father went to Bangor, in car, via Rackliff town & Beach. Got home at 7 o'clock. Margaretta came up in P.M. to stay 2 or 3 days. I canned squash, washed, swept etc. Parker & Freddy took cider apples over to W.O. Mathews.

Wednesday, February 18 10 above zero. Fair. Arne got up apples out of cellar. Freddy helped. Arne packed.

Thursday, February 19 6 above zero. Fair. Arne packed & headed apples. Margaretta stenciled them. Parker took a load to boat with Arne's truck in P.M. I washed. Freddy took over more cider apples & brought back the pulp. Parker came that way from C & brought 3 bbls. of cider.

Friday, February 20 Warm & fair. Parker went over & got rest of cider. Arne, Arno & I went down home with Margaretta. In P.M. went over to Myra's to see Annie Mullin. Joe came over here to see Arne's father. Arne up apples up out of cellar.

Saturday, February 21 I didn't write for a few days so couldn't remember much about this day, but – Arne packed apples. I churned.

Sunday, February 22 Warm & fair. Arne packed apples. Fred, Gladys & children came up in P.M. Frank Smith phoned in evening to tell us that Uncle Ned Barker had passed away in Boston.

Monday, February 23 Rain. Arne packed & headed apples & Freddy stenciled them. Parker went with 16 bbls. with Arne's truck. John Wiley del. 1/4 beef. Myra came in. I wasn't feeling well so didn't do much.

Tuesday, February 24 Warm & Fair. About sick so only did enough for us

to eat. Everett had gray horse to go on line 6. Arne's father got his glasses & can see nicely. Hadn't been able to see creases in baby's wrists before.

Wednesday, February 25 Cloudy & stormy looking. I washed, canned 7 qts. flank beef. Arne got apples up out of cellar into kitchen. Norma came in and read to Arne's father. Marion came in. Marion Heald has typhoid fever. Everett had gray horse to go to E.T. Richards.

Thursday, February 26 Rain, hail & snow. I canned 5 more qts. of beef, swept etc. Marion came over and washed dishes for me. This is Hilda's 28th birthday. Wrote her a letter in the evening. Arne sawed wood. Freddy came in.

Friday, February 27 Cold & windy. I washed. Arne went up on line 17 with truck. Freddy went with him. Brot home some old poles.

Saturday, February 28 Fair. I washed. Parker had sedan to go to Camden & took Arne's father down to Aunt Nells to stay a few days. Arne helped them get ready, wrote letters, went to Ctr, packed apples etc. At 9:21 P.M. felt earthquake that shook whole house & everything in it & lasted for 2 or 3 minutes.

Sunday, March 1 Cloudy all day and started to snow about dark. Arne packed apples. Harry Moody came. Myra, Parker, Marion & Freddy came in. Snow turned to rain during evening.

Monday, March 2 Mostly Fair with snow squalls in P.M. Arne packed, headed & stencil apples and went to boat as soon as dinner. Marion rode down to Grandpa's with him. I mended some, etc. Arne's father came back with him. Myra came in.

Tuesday, March 3 Zero. Fair. I didn't do anything special – cooked etc. Arne cleaned the apples out of the kitchen. Marion came in & brought a coat to Arno that her mother made for him out of one of hers. (Marion)

Wednesday, March 4 Fair & chilly. I washed, swept etc. Arne split wood. Myra & Freddy came in.

Thursday, March 5 Cloudy & stormy looking. I washed. Arne tiered up wood & cleaned up the shed. In P.M. went to the Town Committee meeting at the grange hall. It started to rain about 4 o'clock. Parker, Marion & Freddy

came in. Also Rita.

Friday, March 6 Rain. I washed some of baby's things. Arne mixed hen's grain, mash, scratch grain etc.

Saturday, March 7 Fair. I ironed, churned etc. Arne pruned apple trees. Parker & Myra had sedan to go to Camden. I baked Myra's beans for her. They didn't get back till after dark. Marion stayed down to Reita's till 5 o'clock & then came up here.

Sunday, March 8 Sun shone early but during the day it snowed, hailed and rained. First of evening there was Thunder & Lightning. Marion was here all day. Parker, Myra & Freddy came in. I made strawberry ice cream. Got good radio program in evening.

Monday, March 9 Fair. Town meeting day. Papa put Myrtle in our barn and rode up to the hall with Arne & his father in the sedan. I washed. Irving Eugley, Bert Collamer & L.S. Russ – Selectmen. Fred Hardy, tax collector.

Tuesday, March 10 Cloudy with rain in the evening. I tried to get butter by churning with egg beater but it didn't come. I mended etc. Arne sawed wood, went to Ctr etc. Myra & Marion came in.

Wednesday, March 11 Rain clearing in P.M. Arne went up to Chas. Stevens to fix pone. Getting pretty muddy. Said he shouldn't take the car out again. Marion swept for me. I started to remodel my brown skirt. Arne's father went over to see Norma as she is out of school sick with cold.

Thursday, March 12 Windy & Fair. I washed. Arne pruned apple trees. Marion came in.

Friday, March 13 Fair. I cooked. Arno tipped his carriage over backwards and it threw him out & made his cheek black & blue. Arne pruned apple trees. Norma came in and read to Mr. K. Marion & Freddy came in.

Saturday, March 14 Snowed. I washed some & hung them on clothes horse in kitchen. Arno is 11 months old. We went over to Myra's & got weighed. He weighed 24 ¼ & I 216 ¼. Arne & Freddy went to Ctr. in truck. Norma came in & read to Mr. K. Marion & Parker came in.

Sunday, March 15 Mostly fair. I tried on dresses as I didn't know as I had

anything I could get on to wear to Camden. I found one I could wear. My wedding I could not get on. Norma & Marion came in.

Monday, March 16 Fair & chilly. Parker had Arne's sedan to take Norma back to school. I went along & visited Dentist Long. Had 3 teeth filled. Arne sent 3 box Spy's to Dr. Reuter. Myra came in to tend baby. We got home about 2 o'clock.

Tuesday, March 17 Stormy looking & began to rain in late afternoon. I washed & boiled clothes but didn't get them out. Marion was here to dinner. Myra came in a while in afternoon.

Wednesday, March 18 Fair. I rinsed clothes and hung them out, swept etc. Arne pruned & scraped apple trees. Arno & I went over to Myra's a while in P.M. Marion & Reita came in. Also Parker & Freddy.

Thursday, March 19 Started to rain early in forenoon & cleared first of evening. Rained hard all day with quite a lot of thunder. I cleaned eggs, folded clothes etc. Myra came in. I made ice cream. Marion Reita & Freddy came in.

Friday, March 20 Fair. Arne pruned apple trees. I cleaned eggs. Flora & Marion Hardy came home from Castine for a weeks vacation. Freddy went to Belfast with Parker's team after them. Parker had Arne's truck to go after Norma. Took apples to customers in Camden & brot back grain. Flora came in.

Saturday, March 21 Fair. Arne threw slabs into shop & sawed some, pruned and scraped apple trees. I churned and washed some of baby's clothes. Flora, Norma & Marion came in.

Sunday, March 22 Mostly fair. Arne looked over old wall paper & threw away what was no good. Took Arno out in yard in P.M. in his carriage. Made ice cream. Norma & Marion was in in the afternoon & Flora and Roger in the evening.

Monday, March 23 Fair. Arne, Parker & Freddy sawed slabs with Parker's tractor. I washed. In afternoon took Arno & went over to Myra's a little while. Myra, Flora, Parker, Marion & Freddy were in a[t] different times during the

day.

Tuesday, March 24 Fair. Arne phoned to Bangor & arranged for his father to go up Monday to have his other eye operated on. They both went to Ctr. Arne hauled up apple tree wood that he had pruned off. Parker came over in late afternoon & they sawed it. I ironed etc.

Wednesday, March 25 Cloudy & sprinkled some in P.M. I mended, cooked etc. Went over to Myra's in P.M. Flora & Marion was down to Louise's. The men finished sawing our wood & in P.M. Arne went over & helped with Parker's. Myra & Marion was in.

Thursday, March 26 Fair. Arne & Mr. Basford shingled on back side of house. I did everyday jobs and went over to Myra's in P.M. Myra & Marion was in.

Friday, March 27 Mostly cloudy. Nice a while in forenoon but cloudy & chilly in P.M. Arne & Mr. Basford shingled. I washed some. Flora & Marion came in.

Saturday, March 28 Showery. Mr. Basford didn't come but Arne shingled a while, went to Ctr. etc. I washed towels & baby's clothes. Marion & Myra came in. Also Freddy & Parker.

Sunday, March 29 Partly cloudy. Made ice cream. Parker's folks & Roger came in in evening.

Monday, March 30 Rain. Arne took his father & Herb McCobb to Bangor to have their eyes operated on. Went by way of Camden, started 6:50 A.M. Arne came back this way & got here at 9 P.M. Effie Gray came down in P.M. to stay & help clean house. I washed. Myra came in.

Tuesday, March 31 Partly fair. Mr. Basford came in P.M. Effie cleaned dining room & some in kitchen. Arno was awfully fussy so I couldn't do much.

He took sedan & Arno & I went too. Effic cleaned my bedroom. Parker had truck to go to Camden. Sent case of eggs to Allie. 30¢ per.

Saturday, April 4 Fair. Arne & Mr. Basford put gutter on back side of house & took down stage. Started to put roofing on back side of farther barn. Efficiented little bedroom & chambers. Went up home before supper. Stanley had Arne's wagon to go to Camden. Norma & Marion was in.

Sunday, April 5 Fair & cold. Arne about sick with cold. Papa drove up with

team in forenoon. Only stayed a few minutes. Myra, Parker & Marion came in.

Monday, April 6 Fair & windy. I washed. Arne plowed a little with tractor, tended lambs etc. Marion & Reita came in after school. First day of school. Louise Dyer teacher. Myra came in.

Tuesday, April 7 Fair & windy. Arne & Mr. Basford worked on barn roof. I churned. Myra & Marion came in.

Wednesday, April 8 Fair. Effie came back in A.M. She washed. Arne feeling bum with cold.

Thursday, April 9 Fair. Effie washed. I ironed, mended etc. Arne layed on couch & dozed. Myra & Marion came in.

Friday, April 10 Cloudy with rain in P.M. Effie washed. Arne didn't get up. Had the Dr. come up & see him. He said he has the flu. Left 2 kinds of medicine & said he'd be up again tomorrow.

Saturday, April 11 Fair. Effie washed. I mended, cleaned eggs etc. Arne some better. Dr. came up about 5 o'clock & left him cough medicine. Said if he kept on improving he could come downstairs & lay on couch tomorrow. Myra & Norma came in.

Sunday, April 12 Rainy. Arne came downstairs about noon & stayed all the afternoon. Papa came up a little while. Freddy took Arne's truck & went up & brought his mother down after supper. Myra, Parker, Norma & Marion came in.



Thursday, August 6 Showery. Arne, Arno & I went down to Mr. Meservey's in the morning then Arne hauled lumber for Carl until dinner time. After dinner he hauled slabs for himself. Arno & I went over to Myra's

in P.M.

Friday, August 7 Showery. Arne dusted potatoes & apple trees in A.M. In P.M. he & father went to Camden. I washed front stairs, sewed, swept etc.

Saturday, August 8 Showery. I cooked, washed etc. Arne made 2 trips over to Raymond Libby's to fix phone, mowed lots in both Ctr. cemeteries etc.

Friday, August 14 Showery. I canned rest of peaches & some plums. Arne took case of eggs down to Austin, got a load of lime, spread lime on meadow etc. Let Carl have 2 rolls of building paper. \$3.25 per. Arno 16 mo. old, weighs 29 lbs. He & I went over to Myra's in P.M.

Saturday, August 15 Fair & hot. I washed, canned plums & ironed. Arne harrowed meadow.

Sunday, August 16 Fair & hot. Arne worked in central office a while in A.M. Papa called, while we were eating breakfast, on his way to Belfast. Myra & Marion came in. After baby had nap in P.M. we went down home.

On way back called on Annie Mullin.

Monday, August 17 Fair & hot. I canned blueberries. Arne harrowed meadow. After dinner we went up to Angie Thomas's to put in batteries. We called at Allen Miller's & at Don Patten's to see Lennie. Angie gave us a lovely bouquet of dahlias. Carl had horses etc. to hay. Arne ground scythe for him in A.M.

Tuesday, August 18 Fair & hot. I washed. Arne harrowed meadow. Carl brot horses back in P.M.

Wednesday, August 19 Foggy in morning but burned away some in P.M. Arne & Aunt Emma feeling bum. Arne didn't get up 'til noon. Parker milked for him. I ironed and churned. In P.M. Parker took sedan & carried Myra, Arno, Grandpa & I to Harvest Annual Picnic. Arne butchered sheep in P.M. for Miller.

Thursday, August 20 Fair. I washed. Arne delivered mutton to Miller, picked peas, painted etc. Myra came in a while in the evening.

Friday, August 21 Cloudy & cool. I washed. Arne worked in central office. Expert from Boston working on switch-board & Arne & Everett worked with him. Marion & Geo. Hardy & Parker came in in evening a few min.

Saturday, August 22 Fair. Arne worked in central office in A.M. I swept. In P.M. we went to the Chautauqua. Aunt Emma was so lame she didn't feel like going. We went again in the evening. Arno behaved nicely – slept most of the time.

Sunday, August 23 Fair. Arne worked in Central office in A.M. In P.M. we went down home & stayed to supper.

Saturday, August 29 Fair. Arne worked on meadow in A.M. In P.M. Arne, his father & Aunt Emma went to Mrs. Bill Knight's funeral. Effie churned, washed some etc. etc.

Sunday, August 30 Mostly cloudy. In A.M. Arne picked peas, tomatoes etc. Effie had headache so didn't come down. Arne & Arno went down & got Gladys just before dinner & they picked peas all P.M. Arthur Ames & wife and Oliver & Alta called in P.M. Parker, Myra & Marion came in in evening.

Monday, August 31 Fair & hot. Arne mowed oats in A.M. & worked on meadow in P.M. Effie & Mrs. Heald canned peas.

Sunday, September 13 Rain. Arne went out on lines 2 & 3 in A.M. In P.M. packed apples. Fred, Gladys & children drove up while we were eating supper & brought the corn they canned for us. Marion came in.

Monday, September 14 Fair. Arne packed apples, went to Camden etc. I washed. Papa called on way to hall to vote on Kennebec bridge etc. Arne & father went up. Health officer called & A.L. Young came in a few minutes.

Tuesday, September 15 Fair. Freddy helped Arne haul meadow hay into

orchard with tractor. Mrs. Mathews, Myra & Sarah Daniels called in P.M.

Sunday, December 6 Rain clearing in late afternoon. Arne packed apples in kitchen.

Monday, December 7 Mostly fair. Arne & I walked to grange hall to vote on Standard "Time". I canned 4 pts. Chicken. Arne dug mulching away from

apple trees.

Tuesday, December 8 Mostly fair. Arne worked in orchard. Babies fussy.

Wednesday, December 9 Snow squalls in morning windy & cold in afternoon. Arne went up to Albert Wentworth's to fix phone. Sent 3 bxs apples to Belfast by Parker. He bursted one open so brought them back. Arne made apple boxes. I washed.

Thursday, December 10 Cold & windy. Arne packed apples, went to Farm bureau meeting & in evening went to Odd Fellows & took Everett & Fred with him. Joe Mullin called.

Friday, December 11 Mostly cloudy. I washed some. Arne packed apples etc.

Saturday, December 12 Snow & rain. Arne packed apples. Killed 2 roosters etc.

Sunday, December 13 Snowed in the night. Fair, cold & windy. Arne went up to Albert Wentworth's to fix phone & packed apples. Norma, Marion & Parker came in.

Monday, December 14 Cold & windy. Arne packed apples. I washed. Arno 20 months old. He weighs 31 ¼ lbs. In P.M. he & I went over to Myra's.

Tuesday, December 15 Fair. I hung out clothes etc. & Arne packed apples in forenoon. In P.M. we all went to Camden except Aunt Emma. Myra came in & visited with her. Babies & I had out pictures taken.

Wednesday, December 16 Fair. Arne & Everett worked on line 17. I cooked, swept etc. Flora, Marion & Parker came in.

Thursday, December 17 Cloudy with snow flurries. Arne packed apples, hauled up some wood etc. etc. Parker took truck & went up to Pottle's with cider apples.

Friday, December 18 Fair. Arne went out collecting on lines 10 & 24. I cooked etc. In P.M. Arno & I went in to Myra's a few min. Parker had Arne's truck in P.M. after he got back from Belfast. Stanley called & brot washing

from Effie.

Saturday, December 19 Cloudy with slight snow squalls. Arne worked with Everett on telephone line setting pole. I washed.

Sunday, December 20 Very fine snow most of day. Arne went out collecting. Joe Mullin, Flora & Marion called.

Monday, December 21 I canned pumpkins.

Tuesday, December 22 I churned, cooked etc. In P.M. Arne went up to Albert Wentworth's to fix phone & took Arno with him.

Wednesday, December 23 Arne packed apples & went to Camden. Got photos. Real good.

Thursday, December 24 Arne worked on barn doors, putting on stops etc. In P.M. worked on line on Drinkwater Hill. I washed. Arno hung his stocking for Santa.

Friday, December 25 Snow. Arne went to Searsport & got Rob, to spend the day. Arno got quite a lot of presents, Wheelbarrow, ball, sweater, picture books, handkerchief & 2 darkies to wind up, toothbrush etc. Geneva 4 months old today.

Saturday, December 26 Fair. Arne took Rob back to Searsport. Stoped in Belfast to sell apples. I cooked etc.

Sunday, December 27 14 below Fair. Arne put on storm windows.

Monday, December 28 8 above.

Tuesday, December 29 4 below Fair. Arne packed apples, went up to Horace Miller's on telephone business & went down home with Xmas gifts & got things Hilda sent to us. I was about sick with cold. Cut dress for Arno. Mattie & children spent evening.

Wednesday, December 30 2 below Fair. Arne packed apples. I made Arno's dress & washed some & swept. Myra, Parker & Marion came in.

Thursday, December 31 Mostly fair. Arne helped Everett on line work. I
