led off in one of his off-hand, bombastic speeches, in which he cut into Dodge's position considerably. When the General sat down Dodge rose to reply. He said he had seen in his day a great many men who could not tell so much as they know, but he had never seen one who could tell so much more than he knew as could Gen. Ulmer.
