

[*Letter from Allie Dyer to her aunt Olive Drinkwater Knight who is now married to Arno Knight*]

Castine Feb. 21, 1884

Dear Aunt:-

The school closes next Wednesday. I shall leave here Thursday morning and get in Belfast between ten and eleven. If you can meet me I will come and stay with for Mother will not be at home for three or four weeks to come. It is very icy here now and very hard work to keep on ones feet.

I had a letter from Father & Mother yesterday they had not chartered then, I also had one from Ed & Aunt Alice, they wrote as though they were not coming to Lincolnville. If they don't lets us go up and go to see them and Aunt Lillie. There is going to be a musical concert here next Tuesday evening Guess I shall go. As my little card is full I guess I will close Alice Dyer.
