AN ACT making appropriations for certain fortifications of the United States, for the year one thousand eight hundred and thing ty four.

Be it enacted by the Senate and House of Representatives of the United States of America in Congress assembled, That the follow-lowing sums be, and the same are hereby, appropriated, to be paid out of any unappropriated money in the Treasury, for certain fortifications, viz:

For the preservation of Castle Island, and and repair of Fort Independence, seventeen thousand five hundred and ninety four dol-

lors.

For a fort on George's Island, one hundred thousand dollars.

For Fort Adams, one hundred thousand dollars.

For repairing Fort Columbus and Castle Williams, fifty thousand dollars.

For a fort on Throg's neck, East river, N. York, one hundred thousand dollars.

For rebuilding Fort Delaware, seventy

nine thousand dellars.

For Fort Monroe, fifteen thousand dollars. For Port Calhoun, one hundred and twenty thousand dollars.

For fartifications in Charleston harbor fifty thousand dellars.

For the fort at Cockspur island, Georgia, eighty two thousand dollars.

thousand dollars.

For a fort on Foster's bank, Florida, fifty thousand dollars.

For a fort at Grand Terre, Louisiana, fifty thousand dollars.

For contingencies of fortifications, ten

For completing Fort Macon, repairing the what and dyke and for the protection of

In satisfaction of a contract made with John Urguhart for attending the thoops of the United States, as surgeon from fort Mitchell to Charleston and thouce to Point Comfort, four handged and fifty dollars.
