

Movements of Troops.—To prevent misapprehension and misrepresentation, it is proper to state that, in consequence of the removal of a large number of troops from Florida, and in order to bring together companies of the same regiment for exercise and drill, many changes are in progress in the garrisons of various forts. Among others, two of the four companies now at Fort Adams, Newport, Rhode Island, are ordered to other positions, and their places are to be supplied by an equal number, viz:—One light company of the second regiment of artillery, and one light company of the first artillery, by which these two companies will be enabled to exercise on the very advantageous ground at Fort Adams.
