

Riot.—On Sunday afternoon last, about 30 or 40 Irishmen, laborers on the fortifications in our harbour, commenced a Riot near their residence on the Long-Wharf, proceeding no doubt from intemperance.—By the prompt exertions of that vigilant officer, Mr. TACCART, the Town-Sergeant, aided by several of our active citizens, the disturbance was soon quelled, and the principal rioters committed to prison.
