THE ARMY.—A general order from the Adjutant General's Office, dated at Washington August 27th, assigns the several stations for the regiments of Artillery, as soon as their services in the field can be dispensed with.

The 1st regiment of Artillery are to garrison the forts in New-York harbor, Fort McHenry, &c.

The 2d regiment will garrison the forts in Boston harbor, Newport, and New-London.—Company D. Capt. Drane, will garrison Fort Wolcott, Newport harbor. Company G. Major Lomax, is ordered to Fort Morgan, Mobile.

The general order directs, that the "Colonel of the 2d regiment will take post at Fort Wolcott, the Lt. Col. at Fort Trumbull, and the Major at Fort Constistitution. This arrangement of the field officers of the regiment may be considered as temporary, or until Fort Independence, Boston harbor, and Fort Adams, Newport; R. I. are ready to receive their garrisons. And for the want of quarters at these posts. Companies G. brevet major J. Mountfort, E. Capt. Merchant, and C. Capt. Mellon, will join the garrison at Fort Monroe, Va."
