Totten, shall take the name of **FORT ADAMS**. in compliment, we presume, either to the President himself, or his venerable father. It will be recollected that the redoubts, barracks, &c. which have occupied this site since 1798, and were erected by the Chevalier Tonnard, have always been known by this name.
