BRENTON'S POINT—The Mon Secretary at war has directed, we understand, that the new works, execting at Brenton's Point, for the defence of this Bay, under the superintendence of Col. Tonen, shall take the name of Fort Adams, in compliment, we presume, either to the President himself, or his venerable father. It will be recollected that the redoubts, barracks, &c. which have occupied this seith since 1798, and were erected by the Chevalier Tousard, have always been known by this name.
