THE 159-PASSENGER DC-8, POWERED BY THE NEW ROLLS-ROYCE CONWAY
MARK 15 ENGINES, WILL BE THE MOST POWERFUL COMMERCIAL JET AIRCRAFT IN
THE WORLD. DELIVERY IS SCHEDULED FOR EARLY 1961.

"THIS IS THE JET AIRCRAFT-ENGINE COMBINATION WE HAVE BEEN WAITING
FOR TO MEET THE LONG-RANGE PERFORMANCE REQUIREMENTS OF CPA*S 44,000MILE CANADIAN TRANSCONTINENTAL AND GLOBAL ROUTE PATTERN SERVING FIVE
CONTINENTS, MCCONACHIE SAID.

THE NEW JET AIRLINER WILL FLY VANCOUVER-WINNIPEG IN LESS THAN TWO HOURS, WINNIPEG-TORONTO IN 96 MINUTES, AND WILL RECUCE THE TOKYO-VANCOUVER FLYING TIME TO EIGHT HOURS. IT WILL FLY VANCOUVER TO EUROPE IN 8 HOURS 30 MINUTES AND FROM EDMONTON TO EUROPE IN 7 HOURS 50 MINUTES.
