
FAA Aviation Education Program

Aviation education is an integral element of the agency's mission and is essential to carrying out its responsibilities of promoting aviation and flight safety.

The agency is dedicated to the development and implementation of aviation education programs which provide general education for all citizens and information on aviation careers for America's young people with a special emphasis on women and minority youth.

Aviation Education Resource Centers



FAA Aviation Education Resource Centers (AERCs) are being established at colleges, universities, museums, and foundations to provide a focal point for resources including aviation education programs, publications, software, and videotapes. Designed for students, teachers, and researchers, these materials enhance aviation education and information programs.

Aviation Education Resource Centers provide users with many types of information, for example:

CAREER INFORMATION • Information on various career opportunities in the field of aviation.

SOFTWARE • The Aviation Science Instruction Program (ASIP), describes The Principles of Flight, Navigation and Flight Planning, and Aviation and the Environment. Although the ASIP program is designed primarily for students in the elementary grade, it also has applications for higher grade levels. The ASIP software program is available on Apple IIe. While supplies last, free copies of Microflight (Version 3.0) are available to educators from a donation by Microsoft Corporation and a cooperative agreement with Computer Pilots Association of America. This unique software has a wide range of features providing opportunities for use, not only in enhancing student awareness of aviation, but also in illustrating basic aerodynamic principles and enhancing reading, science, and mathematical skills.

CLASSROOM MATERIALS • Instructional materials are available for teachers and students at all educational levels. These materials consist of timely information to enrich and enhance general studies programs with concepts relating to aviation.

VIDEOTAPES • Videotapes about recent FAA activities related to aviation and education.

PUBLICATIONS • A wide variety of free publications is available. Liberal distribution is suggested for the majority of items—as well as duplication of public domain video and computer media, historical texts, and some limited-distribution pilot information publications. Stock levels of printed materials will be maintained on a semi-annual basis. Individual ordering procedures are also provided for items that are temporarily out of stock at the Centers.


