The Tulsa Airports Improvement Trust was formed and obtained a lease from the City of Tulsa. The trust then sublet the buildings to North American Rockwell Corporation.

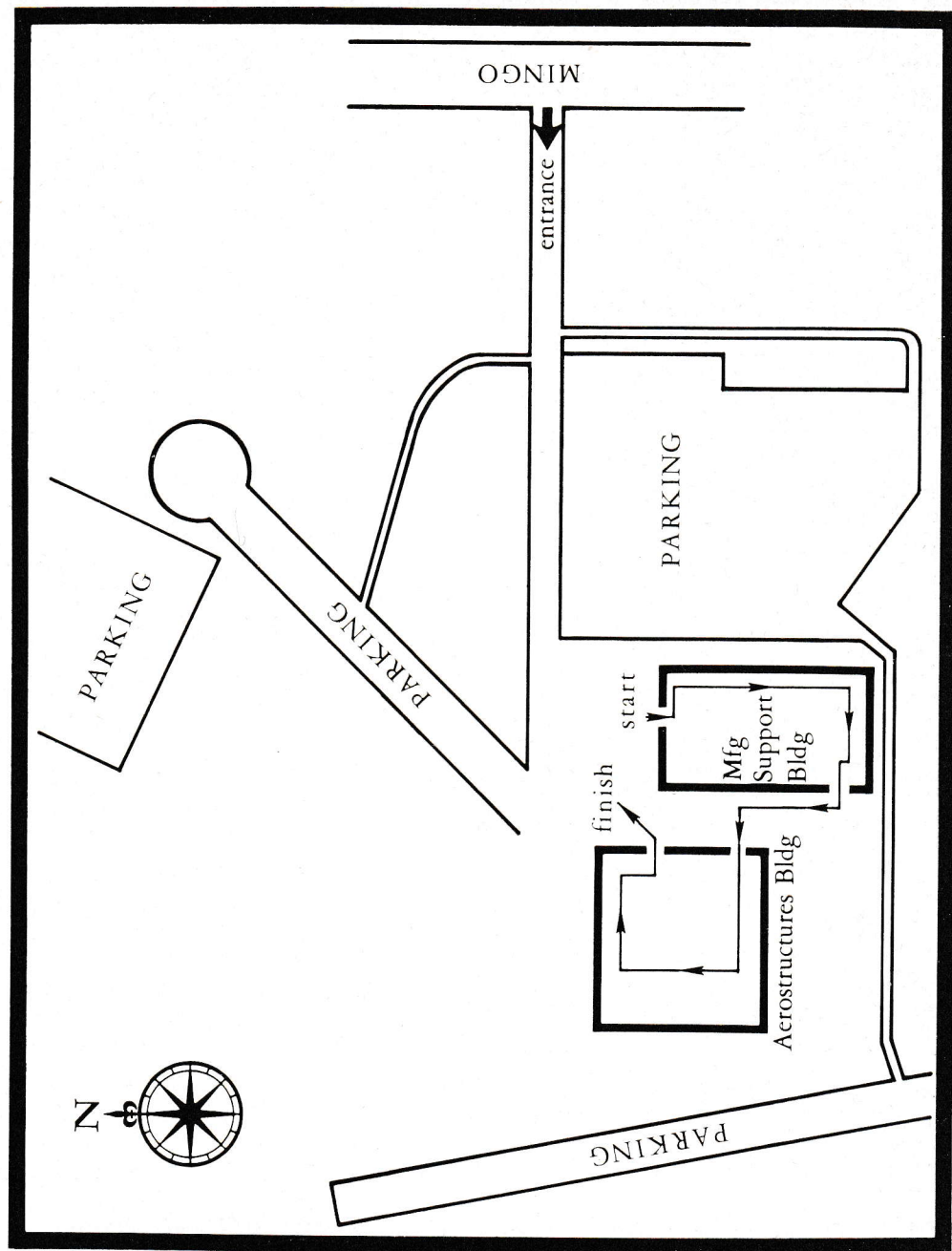
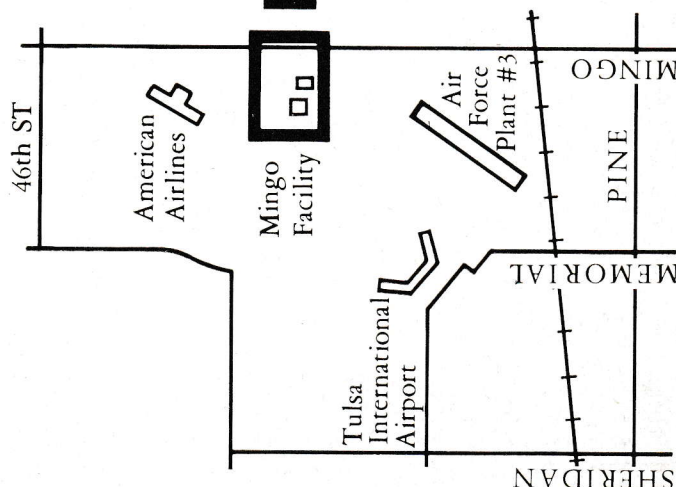
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MINGO FACILITY DEDICATION
