Many townspeople of Capreol turned out to give hearty welcome to still another British bride coming to join her husband in the Railway Town on Friday, when Mrs. Freda Lepki completed her long journey from Swansea, Wales, to Northern Ontario to be reunited with F.O. J. J. Lepki, R.C.A.F., of Capreol. Mrs. Lepki, the former Freda Neil, daughter of Mrs. J. Neil and the late Mr. Neil, of Swansea, was married to F.O. Lepki in April of 1945, a month before her airman-husband was posted back to Canada. It has taken 12 months for the young Welsh bride to get passage to the Dominion to her new home.
