Northern Ontario Railroad Museum and Heritage Centre AGM Highlights Initiatives for 2018

The Northern Ontario Railroad Museum and Heritage Centre held its annual AGM on Thursday, February 22nd, 2018, at the Capreol Millennium Centre.

With the town's centennial year underway, the museum will be focusing much of its attention this coming year on working with other community groups to ensure that the town is able to host a variety of different activities and offer a ton of unique programming to visitors.

Celebrating its own milestone marker, the museum will be kicking off its 25th season of operation by welcoming Al Quiring, star of the Discovery Channel's hit TV series *Highway Thru Hell* to officially open the season on May 19th at the Big Truck Meet Up. The museum will be hosting all of its regularly scheduled programming as well including the Rods N' Rails Classic Car Show, Canada Day, the Capreol Scare Fair as well as the Terror Train 6077.

Several significant capital projects are expected to be completed in time for the grand opening, including the restoration of retired TNO steam locomotive #219 (\$180,000.00) and the restoration of retired Canadian National wooden caboose (\$5,000.00).

The museum's main fundraising initiatives will be centered around raising funds to complete the restoration of Capreol's first police vehicle and the installation of a new irrigation system for the gardens in Prescott Park.

The museum would like to welcome Carol Mulligan who has been nominated as the new secretary for NORMHC, replacing Bob Michelutti. Carol brings a wealth of experience to the board of directors as the museum looks to continue growing and contributing to the economic vitality of Capreol. Bob Michelutti will remain on at the museum as a director at large.

The Northern Ontario Railroad Museum and Heritage Centre would like to thank all of its supporters and is looking forward to seeing many familiar faces around town this coming summer.
