

CBC museum train to stop in Sudbury

CBC-TV welcomes Sudburians on board CBC/Radio-Canada's 50th Anniversary VIA Rail Train, Wednesday, Sept. 18. This is an opportunity to celebrate 50 years of public broadcasting.

Sudbury is the train's only stop in Northern Ontario and one of only a few in the entire province. The train will stop at the VIA station on Elgin Street, across from Sudbury Arena. It will accept "passengers" from 1 to 4 pm. The exhibit closes at 5 pm.

Sudbury has a place in television history. CKSO-TV was the first private television station in Canada and the first CBC-TV affiliate.

The train museum includes a CBC children's programming and memories museum car. Mr. Dressup's tickle trunk and the Rusty and Jerome puppets from *The Friendly Giant* will be on display.
