Dear Eileen,

Trust that this short note, finds you keeping well Eileen. The following (Sellwood, Ontario) photo's, are as follows;

- # 1 Town Site of Sellwood: in which it appears a baseball game is being played, as you'll notice there are 3 or so log cabin's to the Upper Right, I believe one of those, could be the home of my Grandparents JOSEPH & CATHERINE MARIAH (BEST) GILPIN, from 1907 to 1917 time period.
- # 2 Winter Time Logging Photo: the girl to the left is BEA MUNSON & next to Bea, in my (Aunt) MARGARET JANE GILPIN (both are wearing Snow Shoes) its not known who the other two people are in this photo, again the time period is sometime from 1907 to 1917.
- # 3 Joseph L. Gilpin Photo: in which it appears, he might have been out for a walk, near the town site, again the time period, sometime between 1907 & 1917.

My late Aunt MARGARET JANE (GILPIN) ROSS, had these 3 original photo's, (much smaller size photo's 2 to 3 by 4 in size) so I had them enlarged) for you.

QUESTION: In my letter of August 24th./2005, in which I sent you a number of photo's, one in particular of one OLIVE THOMPSON, taken in 1919, in Sudbury, in which you thought that name OLIVE THOMPSON, seemed familiar to you, as if you knew who this young girl was, DO YOU KNOW, WHO SHE IS ???

(there is a GILPIN/QUIGLEY/THOMPSON Name connection to my GILPIN'S, but NO one named OLIVE THOMPSON, from that particular connection)

(have just obtained a another photo of OLIVE THOMPSON, in which on the reverse side of that photo, it says from OLIVE THOMPSON to GLADYS GILPIN)

(the above GLADYS GILPIN, was my late Aunt, born in Copper Cliff, Ontario Dec. 15th/1902 & would have lived in Sellwood, from age 5 in 1907 to age 17 in 1917, before moving onto Sudbury in June or July of 1917)

Please let me know, one way or another, if you know just who this OLIVE THOMPSON, may be.
