

LINKS IN ONTARIO - NORTH AND WEST OF PARRY SOUND
AND OTTAWA.

THUNDERBAY AND NORTHERN ONTARIO RAILWAY.

The first 110 miles north from North Bay was operated in October 1905 by the Commission under special agreement with the Contractors who had not even finished their work.

In 1904 the first section north from New Liskeard to Cochrane was let and on December 31st, 1907, there were 159 miles north from North Bay under operation.

On December 31st, 1908, there was a total mileage under operation of 234.15 miles which includes main lines, branch lines and sidings North Bay to Cochrane.

Contract let for line from Cochrane to Mileage 70, J. B. Ext., on June 11th, 1922.

Line from Cochrane to M.P. 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ taken over for operation November 1st, 1923. Line completed to Mile 70 November 1924.

Contract for extension Mile 70 to 96, let May 31st, 1927, completed October 31st, 1928.

Line from 44 $\frac{1}{2}$ to 96 taken over by Operating Department March 1st, 1930.

Contract for extension 97 to 142 and later extended to include north to James Bay, let on February 22nd, 1930.
