CAPREOL

Capreol was a town that had 3,486 residents according to the 2001 census.

- a railway community, it was built around CN Rail operations.
- to get there, you took either Highway 69 North or Radar Road via Garson.

- the town consisted of a box-kite pair of townships: Norman and Capreol.
