101st Regiment, Ohio Vol. Inf. on the 9th day of August
1862, at _____, by _____

and was mustered into the United States service as such for the period of
three years, on the 30th day of August 1862 at
Camp Monroeville, Ohio, by Cap. Alexander E. Drake

U. S. A. Mustering Officer, and that he was appointed Corporal March 9th,
1863; killed July 7th, 1864, in battle of Chattahoochee, River, Ga.

Was killed at Vinings, not far from Atlanta
probably soon after Battle of Kennesaw Mountain.
Body was moved 18 months afterwarward to
National Cemetery at Marietta Ga. Locatio
of Grave - Section 1 - #9649.
