

LABOR DAY WEEKEND ACTIVITIES

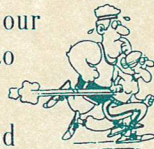

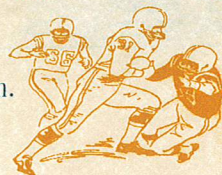
FAMILY FUN OLYMPICS - Get your family warmed up for the '96 games: Bring the whole family to compete against other families in our wacky games.

JUNIOR GOLF CLINIC - Game improving tips for children learning the exciting game of golf. Registration at the Pro-Shop. \$15.00 per child.

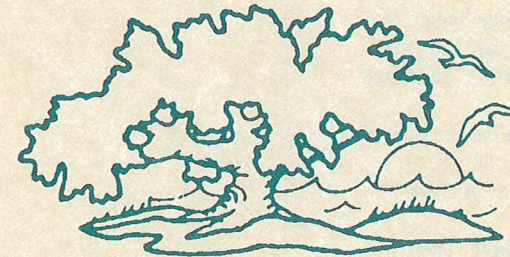
