

At the Yacht Basin boats of guests and the Hotel's own fleet are moored and serviced in sheltered safety.



You may sail a lightning class sailboat from the Hotel fleet, with or without an expert sailor aboard. Lessons too if you wish. Hotel cruisers may be chartered for Gulf fishing, or for across-the-Bay voyages to world-famous Bellingrath Gardens.

For deep-sea fishing in the teeming Gulf of Mexico, or fresh water angling in nearby streams, or simple pole fishing from the Pier good luck is (almost) guaranteed to rod-and-liners.
