

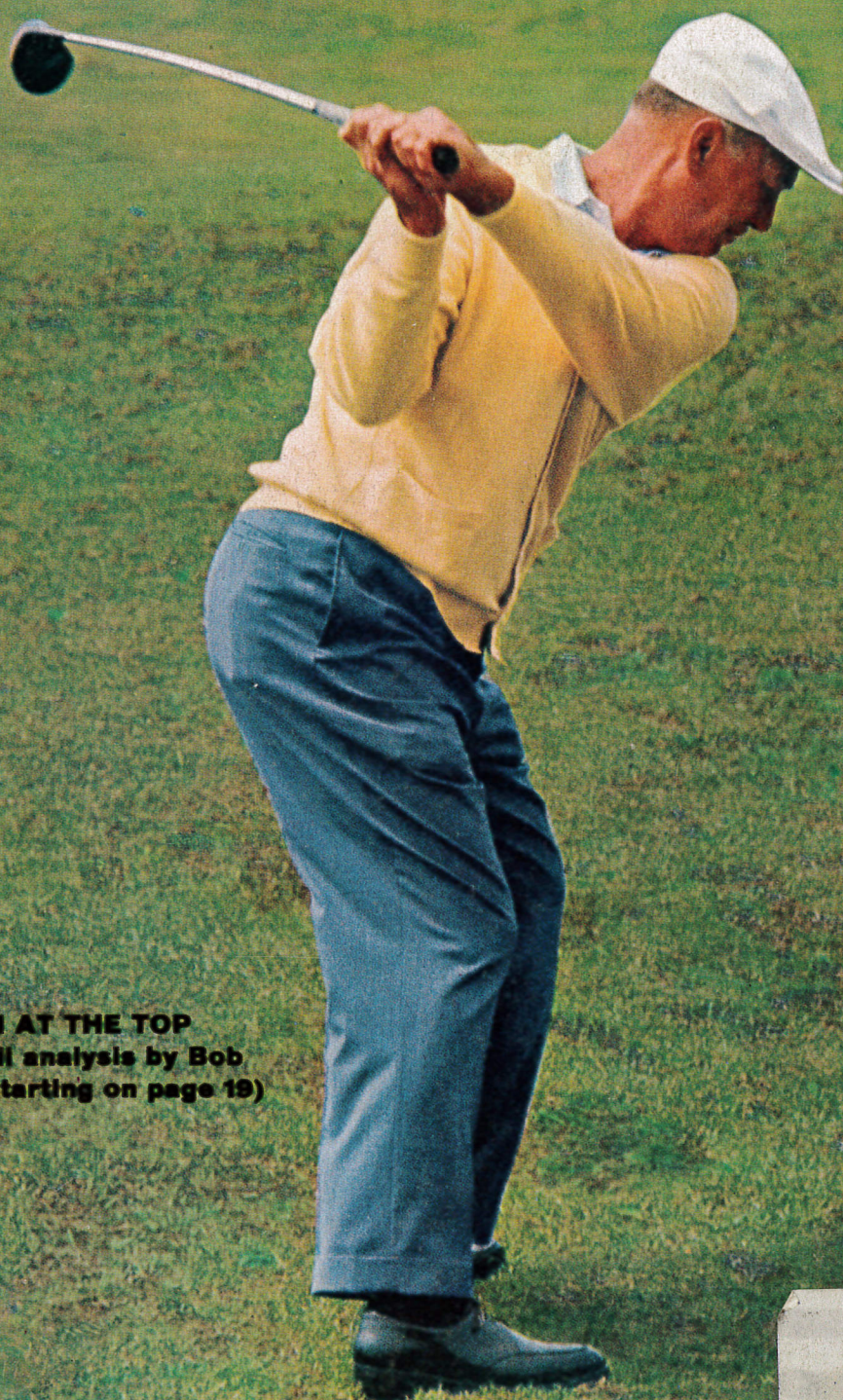

WATERY The farther you drive on the 381-yard, par-4 9th hole on the new Magnolia nine at the Grand Hotel's Lakewood C.C., Point Clear, Ala., the tighter the hole becomes. Two lakes guard the fairway on the left as does a stand of tall trees 210 to 240 yards from the tee. Ideally the tee shot should draw slightly left to land just past the bend of the fairway about 150 yards from the green. Small palmetto trees on the right will catch straight tee shots hit over 225 yards. The second shot must carry a creek and 15 yards of soft fringe to a long, narrow green that slopes down to water on the left.
