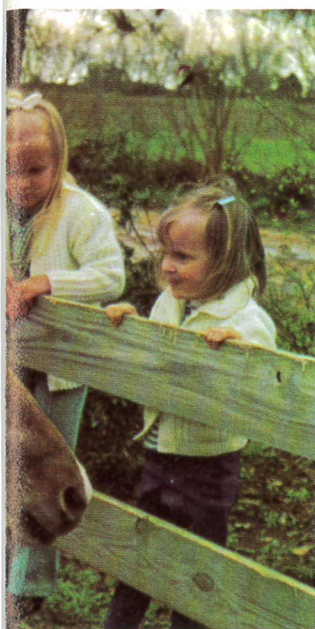


with patio, for 4 people.

On to Bellingrath Gardens, Fort Morgan, antebellum homes, the Battleship USS Alabama and the Submarine USS Drum. Getting to the Point is easy, too. Limousines will meet all planes at Mobile Airport on request. And private planes at Fairhope Airport, with its 5,200 foot asphalt strip, just 4 miles away. Driving? We're just off Route I 10 and 23 miles southeast of Mobile by Battleship Parkway and Route 98 down around the Bay. Or only 49 scenic miles west of Pensacola, Florida.
