During the "Season", Grand Hotel II was the scene of great festivity; boats full of pleasure seekers from Mobile and New Orleans docked at the Hotel pier amid the flying pennants and white sails of the regattas; carriages and tandem bicycles dashed in and out of the drive; blaring bands and picknickers milled about on the broad lawns . . .

By night, all along the shores, Georgia torches—cages filled with blazing pine knots—made splashes of golden brightness. At Grand Hotel, the brilliance of the social season reached full height. Old letters of the period refer to Point Clear as the "Paris of the South", and indeed it was, as it is today, a rendevous of the discriminating.

The present Grand Hotel is as modern as its predecessors were in their times; the warm hospitality and atmosphere of graciousness are traditional. Point Clear visitors of a century ago might be startled if they could return and see the great pool with its under-water lights, and numerous other innovations for service and comfort—but they would feel quite at home in the company of the people who come here today. For now, as in the past, Point Clear reflects the easy going informality characteristic of Grand Hotel I and II.
