

Accused Of Posing As Doctor, Pleads Innocence

GENEVA, Ill. (UPI)—Ricardo Munoz-Velez, 48, accused of posing as a physician and charged with reckless conduct in the treatment of three patients at Elgin State Hospital, pleaded innocent to that charge Thursday before Kane County Circuit Court Judge Thomas Burke.

Munoz Velez was charged

Wednesday by Kane County Assistant State's Attorney Eugene Armentrout. Armentrout said the treatment of three patients who died, allegedly by Munoz-Velez, was negligent medication—or the lack of medication—prescribed by Munoz-Velez. Munoz-Velez was released upon posting a \$7,500 preliminary hearing bond for Oct. 18.
