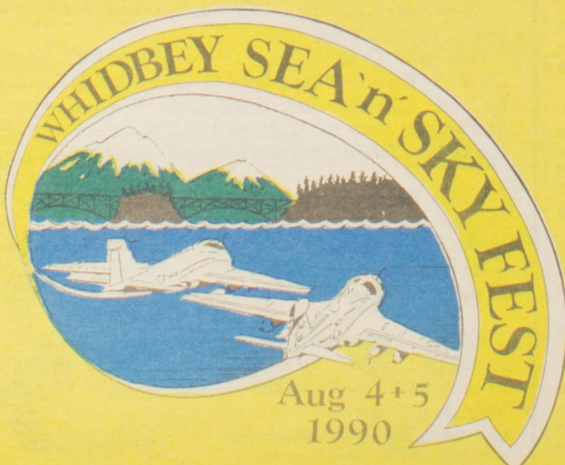


# Sea 'n Sky FEST

# Navy, city cooperating to make Sea 'n Sky a hit

## As many as 100,000 may attend show

**W**hidbey Island Naval Air Station and the city of Oak Harbor joined forces this year to make the annual airshow at the base a major community event.

The 1990 Sea 'n Sky Fest, which takes place Aug. 4 and 5 with events at Ault Field at NAS Whidbey and in downtown Oak Harbor, is made possible by the hard work, planning and dedication of organizers.

"The planning for the fest started, for the community, earlier this year and we've spent thousands of hours planning out all the events," said Linda Wright, the executive director of the Greater Oak Harbor Chamber of Commerce.

"One hundred or more people are trying to make this work, including everyone from the Oak Harbor Police Department to the local businesses," Wright said.

"This event is very special because there has been total participation from the community," Wright said. "For the first time the Navy and the town are cooperating hand in hand and it's been a wonderful experience."

Mary Ann Heiserman, community relations spokesperson at NAS Whidbey, said coordinators started planning for the airshow in November 1989.

"Several of us went to an air show seminar in Las Vegas and signed almost all our civilian aircraft contracts then," Heiserman said. "We went to the seminars to learn how to provide better entertainment, acts

and basically how to run a better air show.

"I think this one will turn out great," she said.

All entertainment on the base, including bands, food and the commercial aircraft demonstrations during the air show, is provided by the NAS Morale, Welfare and Recreation Department.

Community events, including a dance, 10-K run and a pancake breakfast, are sponsored by the Greater Oak Harbor Chamber of Commerce.

"The core idea behind making the air show a community event developed last year when we started planning this year's show, said Tom Linscott, MWR director. "The

thought was, 'wouldn't it be nice to have total community involvement.'

"Overall, I think the program will enhance the military's involvement in the community," he said.

Wright said former NAS Whidbey base commander Barry Sehlin first came to her with the idea of making the air show a community event almost two years ago.

"We tried to get Coupeville and Anacortes involved as well, but unfortunately they weren't interested," Wright said. "But, NAS Whidbey and the city of Oak Harbor were and there was the concept for the fest."

Despite other weekend events that will be happening on Aug. 4 and 5, Wright said she doesn't think it will effect attendance at the fest.

"Regardless of when you choose to do something in the summer, there is always something going on, but we only have three months of good weather we can plan events during, you just have to do it," Wright said.

We're hoping to get between 80,000 and 100,000 people attending the Sea 'n Sky Fest this year since it'll be on the weekend instead of the middle of the week. One thing for sure, it's going to be quite an event," said Cmdr. Jack Zawisza, the airshow's military coordinator.

Other events going on in the Puget Sound area during the Sea 'n Sky Fest are Sea-Fair in Seattle, the closing ceremony for the Goodwill Games and the Anacortes Arts and Crafts Festival.

Sea 'n Sky Fest coordinators agreed planning the event has been frustrating at times, but they also agreed it's been a lot of fun.

"There's a lot more involved in planning the air show than anybody thinks," Heiserman said. "This air show was planned in addition to everybody's normal job, it's been a lot of fun, but it's certainly kept us busy."

"I'm looking forward to next year's fest," Wright said. "I think it'll take at least one time coordinating the show so we can figure out what to do to make it better for next year."

"And I most definitely think this will become a yearly event," she said.

## NAS Whidbey putting out welcome mat for its civilian air show guests

**S**igns along the road to the Whidbey Island Naval Air Station do more than give traffic instructions, they welcome home husbands, fathers, boyfriends and friends from their work at sea and in the air.

At this year's Sea 'n Sky Fest, some of those men will get a chance to show their families and friends just what it is they do "at work".

NAS Whidbey's 172nd Combat Control Squadron parachuting team kick off the air show's opening ceremony doing a mock rescue demonstration with the search and rescue team.

NAS Whidbey Tactical Electronic Warfare Squadron 129 and Medium Attack Squadron 128 will show how the A-6E Intruder and EA-6B Prowler work together to do mock-bombings and an in-flight refueling at 500 feet.

NAS Whidbey is the heart of the west coast training and operation center for the two important carrier-based aircraft, the A-6E Intruder attack bomber and the EA-6B Prowler tactical jammer.

A local favorite, the A-1 Skyraider, which was flown in the major motion picture "Flight of the Intruder" by Whidbey's own Medium Attack Squadron 165, will perform in the air show. Mischä Hausserman will fly the Skyraider.

Traveling at airspeeds more than 600 m.p.h., Capt. John Crook will fly the FA-18 Hornet under "G" Forces from zero to nearly eight times the force of gravity.

Crook is a Heber City, Utah native currently serving a tour as an instructor pilot in the F-18 based out of Lemoore, Calif.

The FA-18 is a strike-fighter

designed to perform both fighter and attack roles for the Navy and the Marines.

Other high performance demonstrations include the F-14 Tomcat, flown by Lt. Mike "Bouvs" Bouvier and Lt. Dave "Animal" Jennings.

The F-14 Tomcat is designed to attack and destroy multiple airborne targets in all weather conditions and at night.

Lt. John Canny and Lt. Gary Peterson from VA-128 will fly the A-6E attack bomber during the air show. The team will show the public what the squadron does during normal flying practice, including low fly-bys, simulated bombing and an aerial refueling.

Other military performances include the A-10 Thunderbolt II, flown by the 12th Air Force A-10

Demonstration Team from the 355th Tactical Fighter Training Wing at Davis-Monthan Air Force Base in Tucson, Ariz.

Four officers and seven noncommissioned officers make up this year's team. The team leader and demonstration pilot is Capt. Gregg Montijo. Team narrators are captains Glenn Ball, Mark Pendley and John Morgan.

The maintenance team is led by Master Sgt. Lee Reed, technical sergeants Mike Porter and Gilbert Mata; staff sergeants Scott Bradshaw, Doug Andrews and Malcolm Nordaby and Sgt. Dave Sepulveda.

While attending the air show, also be sure to check out the displays of the A-6E Intruder, EA-6B Prowler, FA-18 Hornet, F-14 Tomcat and a variety of modern and vintage civilian aircraft.

## Four gates at base will be open to the public to ease congestion

**T**o make your trek to the Sea 'n Sky Fest easier, Whidbey Island Naval Air Station will have four gates open to the public for access to Ault Field, the site of the air show.

Also, be sure to watch for directional signs to the Sea 'n Sky Fest. Allow plenty of time to arrive as traffic can be slow.

The gate schedule is:

North Gate:

— open 9 a.m. to 11 a.m. for inbound traffic only.

Charles Porter Gate:

— open 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. for inbound traffic only.

— open 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. for outbound traffic only.

Ault Field Main Gate:

— open 9 a.m. to 5 p.m. — both directions.

Hospital Gate—

— open 9 a.m. to 1 p.m. for inbound traffic only.

— open 1 p.m. to 5 p.m. for outbound traffic only.

KJTT AM 1110, the local radio station, will broadcast traffic advisory information.

Parking is available at the Seaplane Base with free shuttle service to the air show and returning throughout the day. The shuttle departs every 15 minutes from the Seaplane Base.

RV overnight parking will be available Friday and Saturday night at the Seaplane Base. Space is limited and will be given on a first come, first serve basis.

# Ray-Ban biplanes to fly in formation

**R**ay-Ban Gold, the Canadian aerobatic team, demonstrates precision formation flying in their black-and-gold painted S-2B twin seat biplanes.

The team flies Pitts Special S-2B twin-seat biplanes in a three-plane formation. Cruising speed of the aircraft is 180 mph.

The three-member team was founded by the team's left wing pilot Bill Cowan in 1972. Cowan is now in his 19th air show season.

George Kirbyson is the lead pilot and Al Hauff is right wing pilot. All three are former Royal Canadian Air Force pilots.

The Ray-Ban Gold Aerobatic Team is Canada's only all-civilian aerobatic team and the pilots fly formation aerobatics and air shows as a hobby.

The team will perform Saturday and Sunday at 11:20 a.m.

## Street fair, dance and more planned in Oak Harbor

**W**hile Whidbey Island Naval Air Station will be the hub of activity during the Sea 'n Sky Fest on Aug. 4 and 5, visitors will also find plenty to do in Oak Harbor.

This year's air show marks the first time the Navy and Oak Harbor community have coordinated events to coincide.

"We're expecting to see about 50,000 people a day coming into town

for the show," said Jim Sieboldt, Sea 'n Sky community chairman.

Aside from the wild air show aerobatics at NAS Whidbey, the Greater Oak Harbor Chamber of Commerce and local organizers organized a street fair, a dance, a pancake breakfast, 2K-10K runs and a 4K walk.

Residents and visitors can start Saturday and Sunday off with a pancake breakfast on the Seaplane Base across from the Navy Exchange where a tent will be set up. Breakfast starts at 9 a.m. both days and the cost is \$3 for adults and \$1.50 for youths.

Tickets for the pancake breakfast

are available in advance at the chamber office. All proceeds go to the Red Cross and the chamber of commerce.

The Sea 'n Sky Fest Run and Walk starts at 9 a.m. Saturday across from the Navy Exchange at the Seaplane Base. The course is a flat, scenic loop following the bay, through Oak Harbor and back to the historic Seaplane Base.

During the race, intersections will be patrolled by the city, military police and course officials. Fresh fruit and drinks will be available at the finish line.

First place winners of the 10K will

each receive round trip airfare to the Boston Marathon. A trophy will be given to the first place team in the 10K. Other top place finishers in each division will win a medal or ribbon.

The street fair Saturday and Sunday on West Pioneer Way in downtown Oak Harbor will provide a melange of Oak Harbor's craft enthusiasts displaying their goods.

Joyce Lippus, chairwoman of marketing for the Downtown Development Council, said the street fair will include 20 booths with a variety of crafts, baskets and "all sorts of neat things".

Lippus also said West Pioneer Way

merchants will line the streets with sale racks and tables for a sidewalk sale.

The street fair will take place from 11 a.m. to 6 p.m. on Saturday and 11 a.m. to 5 p.m. on Sunday.

Although no longer a place to skate, the Roller Barn is the place if you want to kick up your heels and dance Saturday night away.

A live band, Timberline Express, will play a "nice mix of '50s, '60s and country music," said Linda Wright, executive director of the greater Oak Harbor chamber.

The free dance is from 8 p.m. Saturday till 1 a.m. Soft-drinks, beer, wine and snacks will be available.

## Skylarks will glide through base show

**T**he Skylark North Glider Aerobatic Team has an unusual way of transporting their gear.

Rather than disassemble the glider and transport it by trailer to each air show, the team loads its gear into the back of the towplane, hooks up the Grob G-102 glider and flies to the show on aero tow.

Spectators will witness this process close-up as the towplane and glider circle around to execute a low pass along the flight line.

Spectators will also see how far the sport of soaring has advanced since 1853 when Sir George Cayley built

and flew the world's first human-carrying glider.

Pilot Alan Arakelian and his co-pilot Rich Benbrook performance includes an aerial ballet choreographed to music.

The Skylark North Aerobatic Team will perform at 1:10 p.m. Saturday and Sunday.

The team performs loops, rolls, Cuban eights, wingovers and inverted flight. A specially-designed smoke system is used to trace these maneuvers in the sky.

The pilots are from the Skylark North Glider Flight School in Tehachapi, Calif.

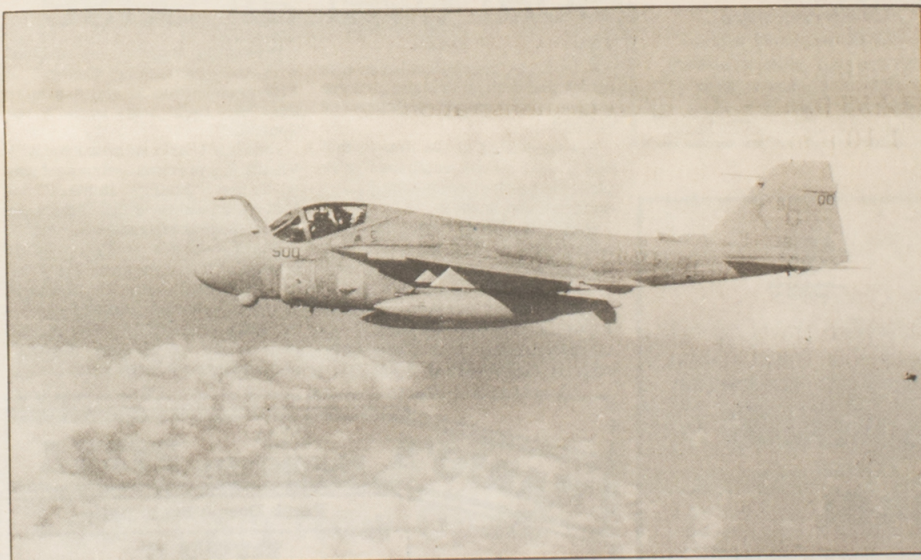

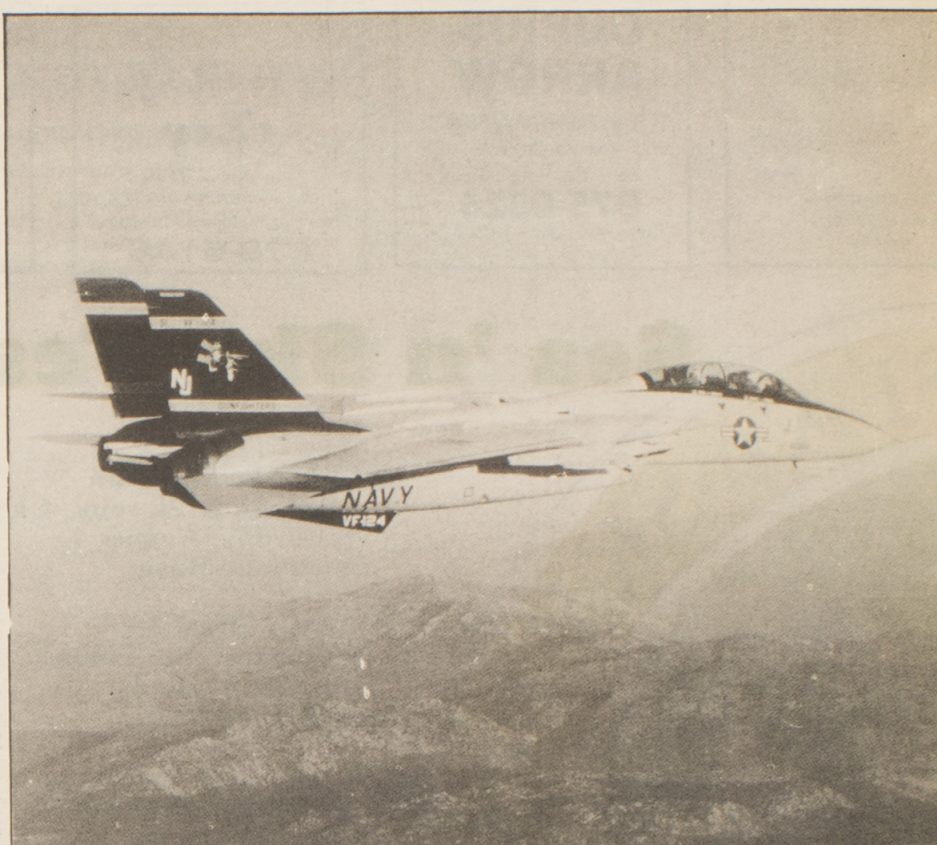

## Destroyer to entertain crowds F-14A Tomcat will soar over air base

The F-14A Tomcat's mission is to attack and destroy multiple airborne targets in all weather conditions and at night.

But spectators at the first annual Sea 'n Sky Fest will watch the fighter plane fly for their enjoyment 3 p.m., Saturday and Sunday.

Flying the plane during the base air show are Lt. Mike "Bouvs" Bouvier and Lt. Dave "Animal" Jennings from Fighter Squadron 124.

Bouvier is one of only two qualified F-14A air show demonstration pilots on the west coast and is also an instructor with VA-124.

Previously, Bouvier was assigned with the "Screaming Eagles" of Fighter Squadron 51 and has more than 1,300 flight hours in the F-14A Tomcat.

Jennings is also an instructor with VA-124. His previous assignment was with the "Bounty Hunters" of Fighter Squadron 2. He has more than 1,400 in the Tomcat.

The F-14A can track up to 24 targets at the same time. The Tomcat is armed with air intercept missiles, rockets and bombs.

F-14A's provided air cover for the joint strike on Libyan terrorist-related targets in 1986.

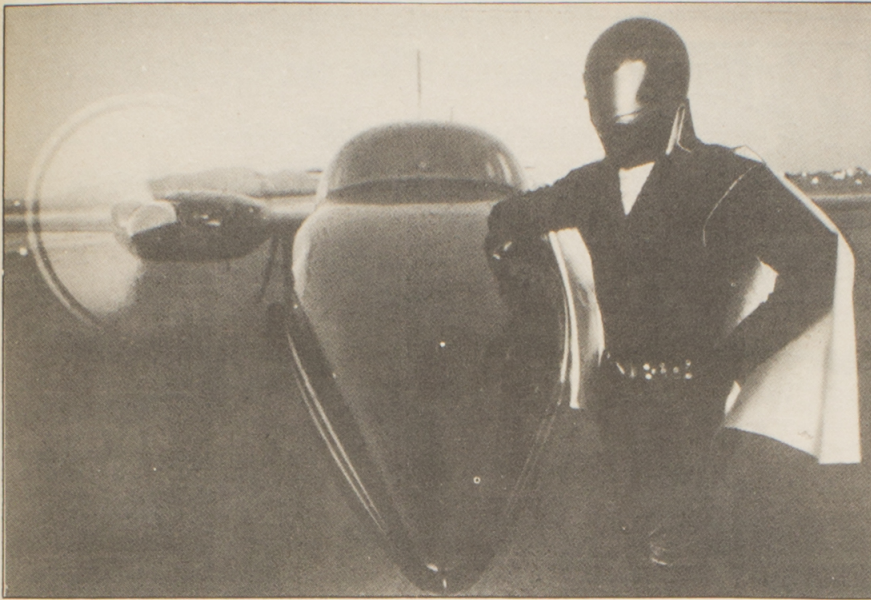

## Silver Bullets to shine in sky above Whidbey

World's smallest planes dazzle and amaze air show spectators

The Silver Bullets zoom straight up, straight down, inverted and even slide backward as the jet executes a high-performance air show routine.

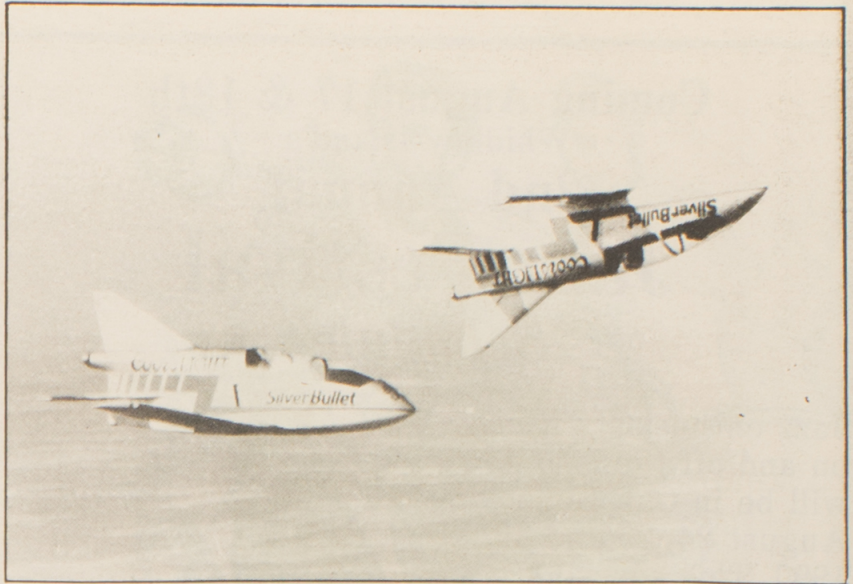
While reaching speeds of 300 mph

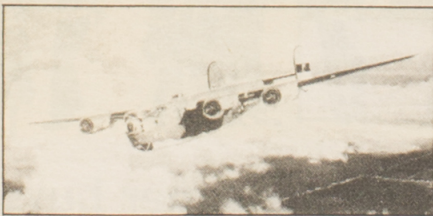
