Blending the old with the new

RESTORING an old house for practical family living without sacrificing oldfashioned charm is a matter of knowing what to save and what to change.

You install new electric wiring, but keep the old pushbutton wall switches. You put on a new roof and replace some of the siding, but you match the original material as closely as possible. Or you turn an old bathroom into a breakfast room but you're careful to furnish it with oak furniture faithful to the era. Then you find an old wood range to add to the modern kitchen.

Donald and Sandy Pease are practiced at the art now that they have nearly finished one of Oak Harbor's oldest homes, the 11-room Loers house on Swantown Road built in 1911.

The old Whidbey Island farmhouse is an architectural standout with its cupolacrowned tower circled by two levels of white-railed porches. Gables, bays, hand-cut shingle trim and a new coat of Williamsburg-blue paint add to the character of the house.

The young owners have lived in the house less than a year, so they are just beginning to acquire furniture that suits the local landmark. They are finding help from unexpected sources.

"People we hardly know have come to give things for the house, they're so happy to have it restored," Mrs. Pease said.

Pease, an electrical contractor, has done much of the restoration work himself.

Mrs. Pease has peeled old wallpaper, stained new cabinets and painted woodwork.

Horace G. Bradt, a Mount Vernon architect, designed the home's new kitchen, laundry room and bathrooms. John Parkhurst, a Whidbey Island builder, has worked with the Peases on the project since it was begun in June, 1973.















Living CONTINUED


