A. D. Blowers, C. P. Dyer, George B. Thornton
Howard B. Lovejoy and Jacob Jensen, all
Citizens of the United States, and the State
of Washington, do hereby associate our-
selves together as a Corporation under
the general Incorporation laws of the
said State of Washington, and do hereby
adopt the following articles of Incorpor-
ation:

Article I

The name of this Corporation shall be.
The Island County Publishing Company.

Article II

The objects for which this Corporation
is formed are, and shall be:

First, To do a general printing and
publishing business under the laws of
the State of Washington.

Second, To own, print, publish and
manage a paper for the diffusion of
general and local news, to own
telegraphic franchises, and publish
the same. To own, print and publish
all kinds of job work, and blanks
of all kinds and descriptions. To buy
and sell papers, books, and all class.

Citizens of the United States, and the State of Washington, do hereby associate ourselves together as a Corporation under the general Incorporation laws of the said State of Washington, and do hereby adopt the following articles of Incorporation:

Article I

The name of this Corporation shall be.
The Island County Publishing Company.

Article II

The objects for which this Corporation is formed are, and shall be:

First To do a general printing and publishing business under the laws of the State of Washington. ✓

Second, To own, print, publish and manage a paper for the diffusion of general and local news, to own telegraphic franchises, and publish the same. To own, print and publish all kinds of job work, and blanks of all kinds and descriptions. to buy and sell papers, books, and all classes of literary matter, and to do all kinds of work, printing and publishing that may be

done by, or in any printing or publishing establishment.

2 ~~Third~~ To purchase or acquire by donation subscription or other wise any lands or tenements to hold, improve, lease, sell or mortgage or otherwise dispose of the same in such a manner as may be deemed proper.

~~Fourth~~ To issue bonds, and to borrow money on bonds, notes, debentures and otherwise for the general purpose of the Corporation or to carry out any of the objects hereinbefore set forth, and to mortgage any and all property real and personal of the Corporation to secure the payment thereof.

~~Fifth~~ To do any and all other things necessary and proper for the accomplishment of the objects above specified.

3 The Capital Stock of this Corporation shall be One thousand Dollars (\$1,000) which shall be divided into One hundred (100) shares of the par value of Ten Dollars (\$10) per share.
