Between 1850 and the mid 1900's, Oak Harbor and Whidbey Island was increasingly inhabited by settlers from North America, Europe and Asia and it remained essentially a community tied to the land.

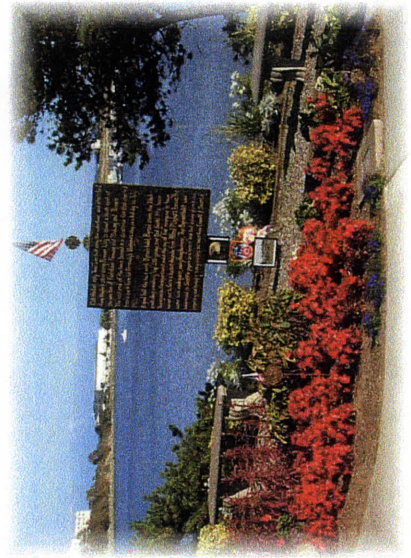
