# FRIDAY, JULY 7, 1972

The tour leaves Sun Valley enroute to Reno, Nevada, a distance of approximately 514 miles. The tour will arrive at the beautiful Century Plaza Hotel, one of the most pretentious hotels in all of the United States. The checkpoint is 6:00 P. M. at Century Plaza, Avenue of the Stars, Century City, Los Angeles.

Restoration Hour is 6:30 P. M. to 7:30 P. M. at the Granada Bar in the Century Plaza.

Dinner and evening are on your own.

### SATURDAY, JULY 15, 1972

Checkpoint: 6:00 P. M. at the Sheraton Irin Airport, San Diego, California

The tour leaves Los Angeles traveling to San Diego, a distance of approximately 135 miles. On this day plan to start early as the tour goes through Anaheim, the home of Disneyland, and some of you may want to stop here for a couple of hours at this fairyland.

The checkpoint is at 6:00 P. M. at the Sheraton Inn Airport, followed by a restoration hour from 6:30 to 7:30 P. M. at the Madrid Room at the Inn.

Dinner and evening are on your own.

## SUNDAY, JULY 16, 1972

Checkpoint: 6:00 P. M., Sheraton Inn Airport, San Diego, California

This is the final day of the tour. All of the tourists will leave together at 10:00 A. M. traveling in convoy to the Mexican Border. A separate line will be formed in going through the Mexican Border. Mexico is going all out to give us the red carpet treatment.

We must be at the border at 11:00 A. M. where we will pick up our motorcyle escorts. We will drive through Tijuana, park at the Avenida Revolution on Main Street, near the Jai-Alai building, for shopping, visiting and sightseeing. There will be three hours allowed for this portion. We then will be escorted back to the United States border, where arrangements have been made to get through the United States Border as fast as possible.
