WEEK-DAY RIDES FOR PRE-SCHOOLERS, KINDERGARTENERS, FIRST GRADERS

The MAGIC AGE OF STEAM will be open for Rides on the following Tuesdays:

From 9:30 to 11:30 A.M. each day. BY RESERVATION ONLY!

Everyone wants the train ride on the 1/8 size Auburn Valley Railroad, the train on which is pulled by a real coal burning steam locomotive. This ride takes 10 minutes and costs 50¢ per child (teachers and drivers free).

The Toonerville Trolley ride takes 5 minutes and costs 25¢ per child.

The 1912 Stanley Steamer "Mountain Wagon" ride takes 5 minutes and costs 25¢ per child, teachers and drivers free.

The miniature Ferris Wheel ride takes 5 minutes and costs 25c. Usually teachers and helpers do not ride the Toonerville Trolley and Ferris Wheel, unless they have some apprehensive youngsters who need their support.

So, you may select one, two, three or four rides, with a cost ranging from 50¢ each to \$1.25 each.

Several souvenir items are for sale for children with spending money, ranging from 10¢ (post cards) to \$1. in price.

The Museum will not be Open on the above dates and times.

The Magic Age of Steam is on Delaware Route 82, 3/10 of a mile from the Pennsylvania Line, just north of the little village of Yorklyn. It is 2 miles northeast of Route 41 at Hockessin, and 4 miles west of Route 52 (Kennett Pike) at Centerville. Wilmington is 10 miles (downtown), and Kennett Square, Pa. is 4 miles. Newark is 12 miles away.
