New groups hosts fund-raiser for Auburn Heights

The Friends of Auburn Heights Preserve and the Marshall Steam Team will host their first fund-raiser on December 27 and 28 in

Yorklyn.

The Holiday Trains at Auburn Heights event will include rides on the 1/8th-scale steam railroad,

tours of the largest collection of operating Stanley Steam automobiles, antique standard-gauge electric train displays, popcorn from a steam-powered popcorn machine and hot chocolate.

The event will be held at the Yorklyn estate of Tom Marshall from 1-4 p.m. Tickets are \$10, \$7 for ages 2-12, cash only.

Marshall donated the estate last year to the state, which plans to include it in a larger Auburn Heights Preserve in the Yorklyn area. The Friends of Auburn Heights was formed to benefit the park, while the Marshall Steam Team maintains the model railroad. The estate is on Rt. 32 north of Yorklyn.
