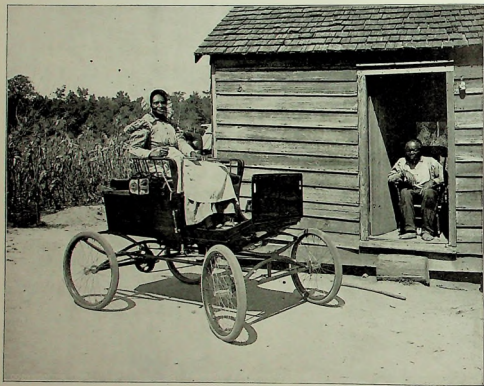
LOCOMOBILE ON AN OVERHANGING CLIFF, GLACIER POINT, YOSEMITE PARK.

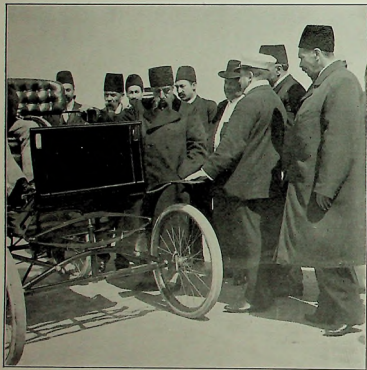

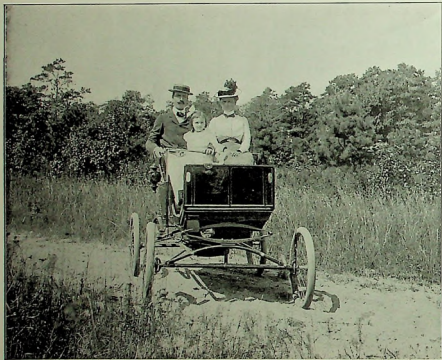
MR. P. F. ROCKETT'S LOCOMOBILE GOING THROUGH ADOBE MUD,
