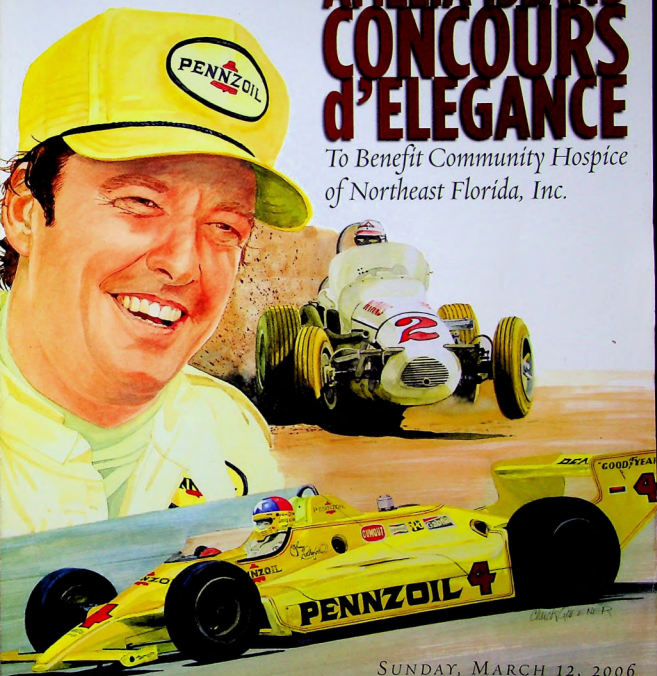

About Community Hospice

Community Hospice of Northeast Florida strives to improve the quality of life for people with life-limiting illnesses and their families and to be the compassionate guide for end-of-life care in our community.

The funds raised through Concours d'Elegance help Community Hospice provide compassionate, hands-on care that brings comfort to patients; support for families and friends caring for a loved one; information and education that can ease fear and anxiety; and the means to make end-of-life wishes known and honored.

Established in 1979 as the first hospice program in northeast Florida, Community Hospice cares for nearly 1,000 patients daily in Baker, Clay, Duval, Nassau and St. Johns counties, through the support of more than 700 employees and 1,100 volunteers. As a nonprofit organization, Community Hospice has served more than 38,000 children and adults—at home, in long-term care facilities, hospitals and through its two inpatient facilities in Jacksonville.

Specialized care is available to all residents of northeast Florida, regardless of their ability to pay. To ensure that everyone has access to end-of-life care, Community Hospice Foundation generates philanthropic and community support for unfunded and under-funded programs, including indigent hospice care, emergency assistance to patients and families in need, education and awareness programs through the Charles M. Neviser Educational Institute, specialized grief and bereavement programs and Community PedsCare, a pediatric palliative and hospice program.
