All are planning on the full weekend, Friday departure to termination Sunday afternoon, except those denoted by an *.

Heather Citron and baby daughter Leah will be traveling in a modern car, and they will not participate in Saturday's activities, except for Heather's joining us for dinner at Sambo's. None of the Citrons will be staying at Home 2 Suites.

Ellen Hopkins will have a modern car, and she will join us for dinner Friday night, but will not attend the brunch on Sunday.

Chazz Salkin hopes to ride down in one of the steamers on Friday, and he and Susan will join us for dinner at Sambo's Saturday night.

Bob Wilhelm will be with us on Saturday, and probably join us for lunch and dinner that day.

Frank and Alma Hix will join us for brunch on Sunday.

Tom and Ruth Marshall will have a modern car available Saturday and Sunday.

Hotel reservations are being held in the name of Tom Marshall, but Home 2 Suites has your name on the list. When you check in, present your credit card, and all charges will be for your individual account.

The Dover Home 2 Suites is an ultra-modern hotel with contemporary furnishings. Breakfast is furnished with your room, and is served from 6:30 to 9:30. It is adequate, but not exceptional.

Dinner Friday night is at "Where Pigs Fly" at 6:30, within walking distance of our hotel.

Saturday lunch will be shortly after 11:30 for those taking the steamer trip to the Air Mobility Command Museum. It will be at Restaurant 55 on south State Street, about 4 miles from our hotel. This group expects to be at the museum, where Mike Leister is the director, from 12:30 to 3:00, approximately.

Susan Salkin is hosting five or six of our ladies for a special tour of Dover between 10:00 and 3:00 on Saturday. Some of this will be walking and some in modern cars, and lunch in Dover is also planned.

Saturday night's dinner is at Sambo's Tavern in Leipsic, about 8 miles from our hotel, at 5 P.M. sharp. We need to leave the hotel by 4:30, and hope to be back not later than 7:00, because of impending darkness.

On Sunday, a leisurely check-out should provide a departure by 11:00 A.M. Our brunch is planned for Cantwell's Tavern in Odessa at 12:30.

Stanleys need Water and Kerosene:

Brian Pepper plans to have a kerosene truck in the parking lot at Home 2 Suites between 9:30 and 10:00 Saturday morning to top off the tanks in all our steamers. Operators should make sure your tanks are full, as this will carry you for the rest of the tour.

On Friday, we have two water stops, at Chesapeake City and at Clayton, 28 and 54 miles from Auburn Heights, respectively. The condensing cars should not need the Clayton stop.

A water hose will be available in the parking lot behind our hotel. We should not need water at other places on Saturday, as our two runs that day are under 25 miles each.

On Sunday, water is available at the Fire House in Odessa at the 27-mile point, and at the Wilmington & Western Railroad's Greenbank Station at the 56-mile point.

Our departure time from Auburn Heights is at 1:00 P.M. SHARP on Friday, and we expect to return to our home base by about 4 P.M. on Sunday.
