

The "OLD PACIFIC" reached New York on August 21, 1903, after 61 days on the road. 51 of those days were needed to travel the difficult and often non-existent roads between San Francisco and Chicago.

Take the steering wheel of a stock Packard Model F, nicknamed "Old Pacific" and cross America over mountains, deserts, and prairies in this game of early automobile adventure.
