SPECIFICATIONS OF THE NEW STANLEY 20 H.P., FIVE PASSENGER TOURING CAR MODEL 720

Wheel base. 130 inches, turning radius smaller than last year's 710.

Wheels. 34 x 41. Demountable rims.

Tires. 34 x 4½ Silvertown Cord. Provision for extra tire on running board forward of front door.

Springs. Semi-elliptical front, full elliptical rear.

Frame. Channel steel.

Mudguards. Crowned; with splasher for radiator.

Brakes. Larger and wider, 14 x 2.

Front Axle. Complete Timken.

Rear Axle. Of continuous housings, which bolted together form the gear case; oscillates in the spring block. Timken bearings throughout.

Engine. Bolted rigidly to the rear axle, and braced from the front of the engine back to the rear axle, thus making a unit of the engine, differential and rear axle.

Pumps. Driven from rear axle at one-quarter engine speed with long stroke.

Steering Gear. On left side, of Warner worm and gear type, with 18 inch wheel.

Lighting System. Electric lights, Apple dynamo geared Willard L. B. A. 6-80 storage battery; electric head-lights black and nickel, large and small bulbs, electric tail and dash lights; no side lights.

Water Tank. Under frame at driver's seat. Main fuel (kerosene) tank under frame at rear, behind axle. Pilot and cylinder oil tank under front seat. Baggage space under rear seat.

Condenser Radiator. Mayo V-shaped, cellular type; water tank capacity 100 to 150 miles.

Boiler. 23 inch; three superheaters.

Burner. Improved drilled type, with several improvements which we believe will yield a steaming capacity equivalent to the 26-inch boiler with slotted burner.

Body. Aluminum; door opening, front 19 inches, rear 20 inches. Front seat 44 inches wide, 18 inches front to back and cushions 8 inches deep. Rear seat 48 inches wide, 20 inches front to back and cushion 10 inches deep. Tonneau space 30 inches from back of front seat to front of back seat.

Top. One-man, fastened to windshield. Quick-acting side curtains.

Windshield. Clear vision, rain vision, ventilating.

Color. Body and wheel spokes dark, rich blue, called Valentine's Russian body blue, with fine gray striping. Running gear, except the wheel spokes, black without striping.
