Oldest steam car ever to make a trans-Continental trip, 60 years old at the time of the trip.

Only steam car ever to complete a trans-Continental tour of America as a member of a recognized tour of antique cars.

Most countries ever visited in a steam car on a single trip
(3) Canada, United States, and Mexico.

Most National Parks visited in a steam car on a single trip
(6) Yellowstone, Grand Tetons, Yosemite, Grand Canyon, Bryce Canyon, Rocky Mountain.

Most person-miles ever accomplished in a steam car on a single trip, 23,777.

Most water ever carried on a steam car, 128 gallons maximum including 20 gallons in cans. (Tanks 108 gallons)

Most kerosene ever carried on a steam car, 52 gallons including 10 gallons in cans. (Tanks 42 gallons)
