I enjoyed my visit with you on February 19.

I would like to order one passenger car body complete with observation railing (and open vestibule on rear end). I believe this is quoted at 82,490.

I would also like to order two (2) passenger car bodies in kit form. These are quoted at \$1,000 each, or \$2,000 for the two.

As to trucks and brakes, I cannot make out with your wheels, being only 3/4" wide. Mine are 1" wide, and I need this extra width to take the wide gauge on my 55° -radius curve. The 4-8-4' s cannot get around this curve unless the gauge is between 7-11/16" and 7-3/4". Can I buy from you everything to make 6-wheel trucks except the wheels and axles? If so, will you quote a price, as I believe we can adapt axles we have to these frames. I believe my wheels are $4\frac{1}{2}"$, so the brake shoes should work 0.K. if I buy brake kits from you, with an ejector. Obviously, everything I have is $7\frac{1}{2}"$ gauge, not $7\frac{1}{8}"$.

I think I am 0.K. on couplers for the time being. I have some old wooden cars which will be retired, and I can probably use the couplers from them.

I would want 4 seats with each passenger car.

I enclose my check for \$3,000 as a deposit, and ask that you put me on your list for delivery this summer. If this is not satisfactory, please advise.

Dear Jim:

Further to my letter of March 1, and your reply, I still have some questions about trucks and your braking system. As mentioned earlier, I would like to adapt your braking system, using the steam ejector which you can furnish.

You may recall, I said I would have difficulty with the 3/4" wide wheels you make because of the wide gauge on my curves. My wheels from LITTLE ENGINES 30+ years ago measure about 15/16" overall width. But I find they are only 4" in diameter, rather than 4½", which I had thought. Is there any way we can adapt your brake shoes and rigging to the size wheels I have? And can I use present wheels and axles from the old Little Engines trucks to make up 6-wheel passenger car trucks, similar to yours?

Now that the weather has improved, I am back working on my track, and hope to have the "loop" open again in a couple of months. It will be fun to run the "Auburn Valley" after 16 years of no trains.

Let me know what you think in due course. Thank you.

Dear Mr. Marshall:

Concerning your letter regarding wheels for the passenger cars. I do not feel comfortable using a 4" diameter wheel in place of a 44" diameter wheel becuase this will lower the truck components to the track and allow a much greater possibility of damage during simple derailments. Even though it is only a 4" difference on the height of the truck, the height tolerance is very small.

I have measured our current wheel and we could machine it to 7/8 wide. If this is still not enough then I think we have two options.

#1. Find a wheel that meets your criteria.
 (I am not aware of any.)

#2. Make a simple pattern and cast you special wheels to meet your requirements. This would cost an extra \$ 400.00. A one time charge and it would be your pattern.

I realize that this may seem like a way to get more business out of you but my intentions are sincere. These Passenger Cars have been designed for optimal looks and function. I just don't feel comfortable using a smaller diameter wheel which might cuase truck damage in the future.

Let me know what you think and let me take this opportunity to thank you for the passenger car order.
