## Section I

### General Provisions

1. PURPOSE: The purpose of the Mobilization Plan of the 45th Division is to provide for the prompt and orderly mobilization of the units of the Division in conformity with the Eighth Corps Area mobilization plan, 1934 and letter (Restricted) Headquarters, Eighth Corps Area, Fort Sam Houston, Texas, dated May 15, 1937.

2. EXECUTION: - a. The mobilization of the 45th Division and induction into Federal Service on the President's call transfers the Division from the service of the several States to Federal Service.

b. The mobilization of the Eighth Corps Area consists of the initial and subsequent mobilization. All active and inactive and subsequent mobilization. All active and inactive units of this Division will be mobilized on M-day in conformity with the Eighth Corps Area Mobilization Plan.

c. The details of mobilization and induction into Federal Service, governing The National Guard, are published in Army Regulations 120 - 10 and 130 - 10.



## Section II

### Assembly of Personnel

3. a. The mobilization of the 45th Division will be ordered by The Eighth Corps Commander, through the Adjutant Generals of the several States, who will in conformity with such instructions proceed with calling into service all units assigned to the Division.

b. On M-day all military activities in the Eighth Corps Area pass to the control of the Commanding General, Eighth Corps. The control will be exercised through the Adjutant Generals of the several States, where units of the 45th Division are located, until concentration of the troops in The Mobilization Center, or as directed by the Commanding General, Eighth Corps.

c. Every active organization of this Division included in the call or order will assemble, on the date specified therein, at its Armory or Drill Hall and be prepared to leave the home station by 3M for the Division Mobilization Center.

d. The Mobilization Center of the 45th Division will be at Fort Sill, Oklahoma, unless otherwise ordered by The Eighth Corps at the time of call.

e. On receipt of orders to mobilize the Commanding General 45th Division and his Chief of Staff will report in person to the State Adjutant General for conference and obtain decision as to the hour and date of opening the Division Headquarters at the Mobilization Center. Request will be made, directing all Division Staff Officers; the Division Headquarters Detachment; Headquarters and Headquarters Company, Special Troops; 45th Signal Company; 45th Military Police Company and the 120th Quartermaster Regiment Motor Transport Companies to proceed to the Mobilization Center as soon as practicable without waiting for the completion of the mobilization of the other organic units of the Division.

f. All members of The Division Staff residing in or near Oklahoma City will report in person to The Division Commander in his office at the Key Building, or in his absence to the Chief of Staff in his office at the Oklahoma Gas & Electric Company Building. Staff officers unable to report in person will report via telegraph or telephone. All Staff Officers will be prepared, fully equipped for Field Service, ready to assume the duties of their assignments as soon as directed. The proper Staff Officers will prepare complete plans and will be responsible for the reception, processing, physical examination, comfort, welfare, morale and training of all incoming troops.

g. The 45th Division Headquarters Detachment; Headquarters and Headquarters Company, 45th Division Special Troops; 45th Signal Company; 45th Military Police Company and 120th Quartermaster Regiment Truck and Car companies, on receipt of call to mobilize, will be prepared for prompt departure from their home stations to the Division Mobilization Center, which may be within 24 hours after receipt of call.



h. In compliance with instructions, Headquarters Eighth Corps Area, Fort Sam Houston Texas, dated 15, May 1937 (Restricted) the following inactive units will be included in The Initial Mobilization when directed and be completed by 30M:

120th Field Artillery Ammunition Train  
120th Quartermaster Company (Service, Division)

Mobilization of these units will be effected on receipt of additional instructions from higher authority.

i. The mobilization of units at home stations, and transportation and movement to the mobilization center will be under the control and direction of the Adjutant General of the State. Immediately upon arrival at the Division Mobilization Center all troops will pass to the command and control of the Commanding General, 45th Division.



### Section III

#### Shelter

1. a-During the first period of mobilization of organizations at the home stations every effort will be made to provide adequate quarters at the Armory. In case of lack of sufficient room for the accomodation of the organization men who cannot be provided for may be permitted to return home nightly to sleep, but such men authorized to sleep out of quarters will report daily at the Armory for duty.

b. On arrival at the Mobilization Center it is expected the present buildings at the National Guard Camp, Fort Sill, Oklahoma with the tentage available will be sufficient to shelter the Division troops as they arrive.



#### Section IV

#### Subsistence

1. a- Officers messes will be organized as soon as practicable on arrival at the Mobilization Center. During the first stages of mobilization at home stations officers may mess with organization messes and pay their proper share for the food.

b. Organization messes will be established at the home stations and continue in operation on route to the Mobilization Center whenever practicable. When not practicable to operate troop messes purchases of meals may be made as prescribed in paragraph 19, A.R. 130-10.

c. Commanding Officers of organization rendezvous will appoint one agent officer for each station, authorized by them to contract indebtedness for the purpose of expediting The Initial Stages of mobilization.

d. Vouchers covering expenses incident to the mobilization of units will be submitted for payment to the nearest disbursing office. (see Par. 17 and 18-A.R. 130-10).



## Section V

### Hospitalization

1. a. In case of sickness while at home station and no Medical Officer is available, The Commanding Officer will employ a civilian physician to treat the sick if necessary; obtain medicines; and when the individual cannot be cared for at his home, provide for suitable hospital accommodations. (see par. 26-A.R. 130-10)

b. Whenever possible use will be made of the services of The Division Medical Service Personnel to administer the sick, and same will be responsible for the treatment, proper care of patients and their hospitalization when needed.

2. The Division Surgeon will make complete plans for the physical inspection, examination and immunization treatments of all personnel of the Division.



## Section VI

### Recruiting

1. On call into Federal Service all Organization Commanders will procure recruits by voluntary enlistment, to fill the units to required strength. Every effort will be made to recruit the units to peace strength prior to departure from the home station. Shortage of personnel will not delay departure for the Mobilization Center.



## Section VII

### Supplies

1. a. The Division supply agents will plan and make special efforts to promptly requisition the Eighth Corps for all equipment and supplies required to properly equip and care for all the troops of the Division. The equipment on hand with the troops and additional stored by the State Quartermaster is deemed sufficient for immediate requirements until the normal supply system can be established based on The Eighth Corps.

b. Fuel and regular supplies not furnished may be purchased in the open market at the lowest prices obtainable in quantities sufficient for immediate use during the period while mobilizing at the home station. Such quantities will not exceed the allowances authorized. (see Par. 17-18 and 27-A.R. 130-10).



## Section VIII

### Federal Property

1. a. All serviceable United States property in the possession of organizations and issued for their use, such as arms, ammunition, equipment, supplies, clothing, motor transportation and other United States Property will be retained by the organization when called into Federal Service and will be transported with the organization at Federal expense.

b. All surplus and unserviceable United States property will be turned over to the United States Property and Disbursing Officer for Oklahoma or his duly appointed agent. Immediately upon mobilization, requisitions will be submitted through channels for all items required to properly equip the unit at the strength as listed in Table I.



Section IX

State Property

1. a. Armories owned or leased by the State of Oklahoma will be used as required during mobilization; upon departure from the home station they will be turned over to the person designated by the Adjutant General of Oklahoma.

b. All State property in the possession of units on mobilization will be left in armories on departure from home stations and turned over to the person designated as responsible for the armory. No Federal funds will be available for the transportation of State property from home stations to camps or the theater of operations.

c. Other property owned by organizations or private individuals, such as automobiles, trucks, motorcycles, etc., if retained by them, must be transported, operated and maintained by the owner at his own expense, and Not at the expense of the United States.



Section X

Training

1. a. Mobilization plans of all units will provide for training in conformity with instructions contained in Mobilization Regulations 3-1, "Training", and General Orders N-1, 1934, Headquarters Third Army.

b. Basic training will be intensified. The amount of training per day will be increased. The least important subjects will be eliminated and only the most essential will be stressed and given priority.

c. Unit Commanders will make necessary plans for training during the initial stages of mobilization based on the situation, condition and status of training of each organization, until higher authority assumes control of training.
