SUMMARY OF GAME RULES

1. Open Season: Pheasants. Hokkaido - no open season. Honshu, Shikoku, Kyushu - 15 November - 15 January.
All other game - Hokkaido - 1 October - 31 January.
Honshu, Shikoku, Kyushu - 1 November - 28 February.
2. Shotguns only permitted, 12 ga. or smaller except that carbines or rifles may be used for boar, bear and deer.
3. Hunting is authorized from sunrise to sunset only.
4. Hunting prohibited from aircraft and wheeled vehicles.
5. Off Limits for Hunting : Within city or town limits, in heavily populated areas, parks, shrines, temple grounds, cemeteries, lands posted as sanctuaries, Imperial hunting grounds, duck-netting preserves, and on base and slopes of Mt. Fuji - between 1 March and 1 December.

6. Legal Game and Daily Bag Limit:

Birds:

Pheasants (3) ; Partridge (5) ; Quail (10) ; Grouse (3) ; Dove (10) ; Ducks (10) ; Bean Goose and White-fronted Goose only (2) ; Woodcock and Snipe (10) ; Rails, Coots and Gallinules (10) ; Crows and Sparrows, no limit.

Animals:

Deer, Black Bear, Brown Bear (1 per season) ; Boar, Badger, Fox, Raccoon-dog, Rabbit, Weasel, Marten, Squirrel, (no bag limit).

7. It is prohibited to hunt, kill or possess:

Swans, Mandarin Ducks, Mountain Goats, Otters, Monkeys and all other species not listed above as legal game.

BE A SPORTSMAN OBSERVE The GAME LAWS

This permit must be carried on the person when hunting and must be shown upon request to any properly accredited Occupation authority.

Personnel between ages of 14 and 17 years, inclusive, are permitted to hunt only when accompanied by an experienced, licensed hunter.

Personnel under 14 years of age are not permitted to hunt.
