	1745	DP, OD reports nothing has been done about Mongolians at DP. To be checked with AMG. 20 May 45
	2000	Lt. DiGiacomanda report to Regtl. 1 at 211245. 21 May 45
	1730	Mongolians have been sent to Furstenfeldbruck to Okla. PW Cage. 47 undesirable PW's were returned to Okla. PW.
	2000	47 new German PW's brought to our cage.
	2100	145 PW's given typhus shots completing all shots. 22 May 45
	1250	Fern 32's will be in tomorrow definitely, maybe tonight. S-4 to Maj. Meaders.
	1430	Capt. Scott will report at 1600 to Regt. with a special detail of 2 off. and 12 EM. Nature of duties and duration indefinite.
	2225	Ans. to Capt. Kerker's call referring to stopping veh.- GI veh. without trip tickets will be sent back where they came from. S-2 section presented Lt. Burke of AMG with a Jerry Jeep. Civilian veh. without authorization impounded and civilian sent on their way. Ditto for civilians in Gov't veh. (as in case of cap veh. which has been turned over to civilian) This notified by Maj. 	1100	All road-blocks will be discontinued except Dachau Area Command Traffic Control Posts (Maj. Keirse) Baker notified. S-2 section policed up all known SS men in Dachau (48 men) Disposition of SS men to date: PW Channels 43, Bastille 2, CIC 3. 25 May 45 26 May 45
	0200	PW for S-2. PW with no paper at Post 9. Impounded civilian car at Post 11, to be picked up. S-2 section went out to pick up PW at Post 9. There were five when we got there. Went back with a truck and then there were 7. They multiply like rabbits. Also picked up 6 SS at Bastille and they were taken to Furstenfeldbruck.

	1018	Lt. Teichmann called in relation to disposition of Co.'s when we were at Munich. Wants one of the officers to call him as soon as possible at Pasport 3 Forward of Rear CP. S-2 section got a message from Regt. 20 plunderers at Niuhibereich. Plunderers from DP Lager in Karlsfeld No guards on DP. Russians and Peles run around loose. Plunderers killed 2 pigs. The pigs were returned. 28 May 45
	1400	S-2 from Regt and Lt. DiGiacomandea with section went out to Russian DP at Karlsfeld. Approx. 700 men there Made Russians destroy the truck they used Sunday when plundering and got the pigs. Capt. Whitman will take it up with Div. Will notify us if he gets more information Capt. Whitman called that Div. would take care of DP at Karlsfeld. 29 May 45
	1145	250 more PW's brought to our cage. Lt. Bias, 3rd Bn. officer will be over to play ball with our officers at 1800.

	1140	Lt. DiGiacomandea and S-2 section investigating and reported on meat theft at meat warehouse. Questioned interpreter (SS man's wife) and got the name of the culprit.

	1530	S-2 section caught 1 more SS man. He was put into the Bastille.

		S-2 section caught soldier whom we thought was implicated in meat warehouse robbery. 31 May 45
